- For in it God's righteousness is being revealed by reason of faith and toward faith, just as it is written; But the righteous one, by means of faith he will live. (Romans 1:17)
- And be found in union with him, having, not my own righteousness, which results from Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness that issues from God on the basis of faith. (Philippians 3:9)
- It is unthinkable of you that you are acting in this manner to put to death the righteous man with the wicked one so that it has to occur with the righteous man as it does with the wicked! It is unthinkable of you. Is the Judge of all the earth not going to do what is right? (Genesis 18:25)
