WRONGDOERS - TO BE SWEPT AWAY

- Samuel ··· Statement ··· Wrongdoers Swept Away If you flagrantly do what is bad you and your king will be swept away (1 Samuel 12:25) [13] References
- But if you flagrantly do what is bad, you will be swept away, both you and your king.

[13] - References

- In case You should leave Yehowah and You do serve foreign gods, he also will certainly turn back and do You injury and exterminate You after he has done You good. (Joshua 24:20)
- Yehowah will march you and your king whom you will set up over you to a nation whom you have not known, neither you nor your forefathers, and there you will have to serve other gods, of wood and of stone. (Deuteronomy 28:36)
- And it must occur that if you should at all forget Yehowah your God and you should actually walk after other gods and serve them and bow down to them, I do bear witness against you today that you people will absolutely perish. (Deuteronomy 8:19)
- But if your heart turns away and you do not listen, and you are actually seduced and bow down to other gods and serve them.
 (Deuteronomy 30:17)
- But Samuel said to Saul; I shall not return with you, for you have rejected the word of Yehowah, and Yehowah rejects you from continuing as king over Israel. (1 Samuel 15:26)
- And David went on to say; As Yehowah is living, Yehowah himself will deal him a blow, or his day will come and he will have to die, or down into battle he will go, and he will certainly be swept away. (1 Samuel 26:10)
- And Yehowah will also give Israel with you into the hand of the Philistines, and tomorrow you and your sons will be with me. Even the camp of Israel Yehowah will give into the hand of the Philistines. (1 Samuel 28:19)

- Now the Philistines were fighting against Israel, and the men of Israel took to flight from before the Philistines, and they kept falling down slain in Mount Gilboa. (1 Samuel 31:1)
- And Yehowah will indeed strike Israel down, just as the reed sways in the water, and he will certainly uproot Israel off this good ground that he gave to their forefathers, and he will indeed scatter them beyond the River, for the reason that they made their sacred poles, so offending Yehowah. (1 Kings 14:15)
- Thus Saul and three sons of his died, and all those of his house died together. (1 Chronicles 10:6)
- But if you people refuse and are actually rebellious, with a sword you will be eaten up, for the very mouth of Yehowah has spoken it. (Isaiah 1:20)
- And the crash of revolters and that of sinful ones will be at the same time, and those leaving Yehowah will come to their finish. (Isaiah 1:28)
- I proceeded to give you a king in my anger, and I shall take him away in my fury. (Hosea 13:11)
