Zechariah 7:14. And I proceeded tempestuously to hurl them throughout all the nations that they had not known, and the land itself has been left desolate behind them, with no one passing through and with no one returning, and they proceeded to make the desirable land an object of astonishment.

- And You I shall scatter among the nations, and I will unsheathe a sword after You, and Your land must become a desolation, and Your cities will become a desolate ruin. (Leviticus 26:33)
- And Yehowah will certainly scatter you among all the peoples from the one end of the earth to the other end of the earth, and there you will have to serve other gods whom you have not known, neither you nor your forefathers, wood and stone. (Deuteronomy 28:64)
- The fruitage of your ground and all your production a people will eat whom you have not known, and you must become one who is only defrauded and crushed always. (Deuteronomy 28:33)
- Here I am bringing in upon you men a nation from far away, O house of Israel, is the utterance of Yehowah. It is an enduring nation. It is a nation of long ago, a nation whose language you do not know, and you cannot hear understandingly what they speak. (Jeremiah 5:15)
- And I will send the wild beasts of the field among YOU, and they will certainly bereave YOU of children and cut off YOUR domestic animals and reduce the number of YOU, and YOUR roads will actually be desolated. (Leviticus 26:22)
- To fulfill Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had paid off its Sabbaths. All the days of lying desolated it kept Sabbath, to fulfill seventy years. (2 Chronicles 36:21)

- For Yehowah your God is bringing you into a good land, a land of torrent valleys of water, springs and watery deeps issuing forth in the valley plain and in the mountainous region. (Deuteronomy 8:7)
- A land that Yehowah your God is caring for. The eyes of Yehowah your God are constantly upon it, from the beginning of the year to the close of the year. (Deuteronomy 11:12)
- And Haman proceeded to say to King Ahasuerus; There is one certain people scattered and separated among the peoples in all the jurisdictional districts of your realm, and their Laws are different from all other peoples, and the king's own Laws they are not performing, and for the king it is not appropriate to let them alone. (Esther 3:8)

(Ezekiel 12:19)
- In that day I lifted up my hand in an oath to them to bring them forth from the land of Egypt to a land that I had spied out for them, one flowing with milk and honey. It was the decoration of all the lands. (Ezekiel 20:6)
- And I myself also lifted up my hand in an oath to them in the wilderness, not to bring them into the land that I had given, one flowing with milk and honey, it is the decoration of all the lands. (Ezekiel 20:15)
