Zechariah 7:14 And I proceeded tempestuously to hurl them throughout all the nations that they had not known, and the land itself has been left desolate behind them, with no one passing through and with no one returning, and they proceeded to make the desirable land an object of astonishment.

- And **YOU** I shall scatter among the **nations**, and I will unsheathe a sword after **YOU**, and **YOUR land** must become a desolation, and **YOUR** cities will become a **desolate** ruin. (**Leviticus 26:33**)
- And Yehowah will certainly scatter you among all the peoples from the one end of the earth to the other end of the earth, and there you will have to serve other gods whom you have not **known**, neither you nor your forefathers, wood and stone. (**Deuteronomy 28:64**)
- The fruitage of your ground and all your production a people will eat whom you have not **known**, and you must become one who is only defrauded and crushed always. (**Deuteronomy 28:33**)
- Here I am bringing in upon **YOU** men a nation from far away, O house of Israel, is the utterance of Yehowah. It is an enduring nation. It is a nation of long ago, a nation whose language you do not know, and you cannot hear understandingly what they speak. (**Jeremiah 5:15**)
- And I will send the wild beasts of the field among **YOU**, and they will certainly bereave **YOU** of children and cut off **YOUR** domestic animals and reduce the number of **YOU**, and **YOUR** roads will actually be desolated. (**Leviticus 26:22**)
- To fulfill Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the **land** had paid off its Sabbaths. All the days of lying desolated it kept Sabbath, to fulfill seventy years. (**2 Chronicles 36:21**)

- For Yehowah your God is bringing you into a good **land**, a **land** of torrent valleys of water, springs and watery deeps issuing forth in the valley plain and in the mountainous region. (**Deuteronomy 8:7**)
- A **land** that Yehowah your God is caring for. The eyes of Yehowah your God are constantly upon it, from the beginning of the year to the close of the year. (**Deuteronomy 11:12**)
- And Haman **proceeded** to say to King Ahasuerus; There is one certain people scattered and separated among the peoples in all the jurisdictional districts of your realm, and their Laws are different from all other peoples, and the king's own Laws they are not performing, and for the king it is not appropriate to let them alone. (**Esther 3:8**)
- And I will scatter them among the **nations** that neither they nor their fathers have **known**, and I will send after them the sword until I shall have exterminated them. (**Jeremiah 9:16**)
- And you must say to the people of the **land**, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah **has** said to the inhabitants of Jerusalem upon the soil of Israel; With anxious care their bread they will eat, and with horror their water they will drink, in order, that its **land** may be laid **desolate** of its fullness because of the violence of all those dwelling in it. (**Ezekiel 12:19**)
- In that day I lifted up my hand in an oath to them to bring them forth from the **land** of Egypt to a **land** that I had spied out for them, one flowing with milk and honey. It was the decoration of all the **lands**. (**Ezekiel 20:6**)
- And I myself also lifted up my hand in an oath to them in the wilderness, not to bring them into the **land** that I had given, one flowing with milk and honey, it is the decoration of all the **lands**. (**Ezekiel 20:15**)
