YEHOWAH - IS BRINGING YOU FORTH TO A LAND WHEAT, BARLEY, FIGS

Moses ··· Statement ··· Yehowah - Is bringing you forth to a land of wheat, barley vines and figs, pomegranates oil olives and honey (Deuteronomy 8:8) [20] - References

Deuteronomy 8:8... A land of wheat and barley and vines and figs and pomegranates, a land of oil olives and honey,

[20] - References

- When they came to the torrent valley of Eshcol, they then proceeded to cut down from there a shoot with one cluster of grapes. And they went carrying it with a bar on two of the men, and also some of the pomegranates and some of the figs. (Numbers 13:23)
- In that day I lifted up my hand in an oath to them to bring them forth from the land of Egypt to a land that I had spied out for them, one flowing with milk and honey. It was the decoration of all the lands. (Ezekiel 20:6)
- And it must occur that when Yehowah will have brought you into the land of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Hivites and the Jebusites, which he swore to your forefathers to give you, a land flowing with milk and honey, then you must render this service in this month. (Exodus 13:5)
- Hence I said to You; You, for Your part, will take possession of their ground, and I, for my part, shall give it to You to take possession of it, a land flowing with milk and honey. Yehowah Your God I am, who have divided You off from the peoples. (Leviticus 20:24)
- And why have you conducted us up out of Egypt to bring us into this evil place? It is no place of seed and figs and vines and pomegranates, and there is no water to drink. (Numbers 20:5)
- Then he brought us to this place and gave us this land, a land flowing with milk and honey. (Deuteronomy 26:9)
- Do look down from your holy dwelling, the heavens, and bless your people Israel and the soil that you have given us, just as you swore to our forefathers, the land flowing with milk and honey. (Deuteronomy 26:15)

- He kept making him ride upon earth's high places, so that he ate the produce of the field. And he kept making him suck honey out of a crag, and oil out of a flinty rock. (Deuteronomy 32:13)
- And with the choice things of the earth and its fullness, and with the approval of the One residing in the thornbush. May they come upon the head of Joseph and upon the crown of the head of the one singled out from his brothers. (Deuteronomy 33:16)
- And Israel will reside in security, the fountain of Jacob by itself, upon a land of grain and new wine. Yes, his heavens will let the dew drip down. (Deuteronomy 33:28)
- Thus I gave you a land for which you had not toiled and cities that you had not built, and you took up dwelling in them. Vineyards and olive groves that you did not plant are what you are eating. (Joshua 24:13)
- And all those of the land came into the woods, when honey happened to be over all the surface of the field. (1 Samuel 14:25)
- And there was a man that came from Baal-shalishah, and he came bringing to the man of the true God bread of the first ripe fruits, twenty barley loaves, and new grain in his bread bag. Then he said; Give it to the people that they may eat. (2 Kings 4:42)
- Until I come and I actually take You to a land like YOUR own land, a land of grain and new wine, a land of bread and vineyards, a land of oil-olive trees and honey, and keep living that YOU may not die. And do not listen to Hezekiah, for he allures YOU, saying; Yehowah himself will deliver us. (2 Kings 18:32)
- And he himself warred against the king of the sons of Ammon and eventually proved stronger than they were, so that the sons of Ammon gave him in that year a hundred silver talents and ten thousand cor measures of wheat and ten thousand of barley. This was what the sons of Ammon paid to him, also in the second year and the third. (2 Chronicles 27:5)
- And that they should make proclamation and cause a call to pass throughout all their cities and throughout Jerusalem, saying; Go out to the mountainous region and bring in olive leaves and the leaves of oil trees and myrtle leaves and palm leaves and the leaves of branchy trees to make booths, according to what is written. (Nehemiah 8:15)
- In those days I saw in Judah people treading winepresses on the Sabbath and bringing in grain heaps and loading them upon asses, and

also wine, grapes and figs and every sort of burden, and bringing them into Jerusalem on the Sabbath day, and I proceeded to bear witness against them on the day of their selling provisions. (Nehemiah 13:15)

- He is putting peace in your territory, with the fat of the wheat he keeps satisfying you. (Psalms 147:14)
- Do let us rise early and go to the vineyards, that we may see whether the vine has sprouted, the blossom has burst open, the pomegranate trees have bloomed. There I shall give my expressions of endearment to you. (Song of Solomon 7:12)
- Judah and the land of Israel themselves were your traders. For the wheat of Minnith and special foodstuff and honey and oil and balsam, your articles of exchange were given. (Ezekiel 27:17)
