YEHOWAH - WILL ESTABLISH YOU AS A HOLY PEOPLE

Moses *** Statement *** Yehowah - Will establish you as a holy people because you continue to walk in his commandments* (Deuteronomy 28:9) [10] - References

Deuteronomy 28:9" Yehowah will establish you as a holy people to himself, just as he swore to you, because you continue to keep the commandments of Yehowah your God, and you have walked in his ways.

[10] - References

- For you are a holy people to Yehowah your God. It is you Yehowah your God has chosen to become his people, a special property, out of all the peoples that are on the surface of the ground. (Deuteronomy 7:6)
- But, in accord with the Holy One who called You, do You also become holy yourselves in all Your conduct. (1 Peter 1:15)
- And I will carry out my covenant between me and you and your seed after you according to their generations for a covenant to time indefinite, to prove myself God to you and to your seed after you. (Genesis 17:7)
- And you yourselves will become to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. These are the words that you are to say to the sons of Israel. (Exodus 19:6)
- But it was because of Yehowah's loving YOU, and because of his keeping the sworn statement that he had sworn to YOUR forefathers, that Yehowah brought YOU out with a strong hand, that he might redeem you from the house of slaves, from the hand of Pharaoh the king of Egypt. (Deuteronomy 7:8)
- For when God made his promise to Abraham, since he could not swear by anyone greater, he swore by himself. (Hebrews 6:13)
- And Moses together with the older men of Israel went on to command the people, saying; There should be an observing of every commandment that I am commanding you today. (Deuteronomy 27:1)

- For you are a holy people to Yehowah your God, and Yehowah has chosen you to become his people, a special property, out of all the peoples who are on the surface of the ground. (Deuteronomy 14:2)
- And that he will put you high above all the other nations that he has made, resulting in praise and reputation and beauty, while you prove yourself a people holy to Yehowah your God, just as he has promised. (Deuteronomy 26:19)
- For the purpose of establishing you today as his people and that he may prove himself your God, just as he has promised you and just as he has sworn to your forefathers Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. (Deuteronomy 29:13)
