Moses *** Statement *** Yehowah - Your God you should fear, him you should serve and cling to and by his name you should make sworn statements* (Deuteronomy 10:20) [19] - References

Deuteronomy 10:20... Yehowah your God you should fear. Him you should serve, and to him you should cling, and by his name you should make sworn statements.

[19] - References

- Yehowah your God you should fear, and him you should serve, and by his name you should swear. (Deuteronomy 6:13)
- In reply Jesus said to him; It is written: It is Yehowah your God you must worship, and it is to him alone you must render sacred service. (Luke 4:8)
- After Yehowah your God you should walk, and him you should fear, and his commandments you should keep, and to his voice you should listen, and him you should serve, and to him you should cling. (Deuteronomy 13:4)
- Yehowah your God you should fear, and him you should serve, and by his name you should swear. (Deuteronomy 6:13)
- But you who are cleaving to Yehowah your God are all of you alive today. (Deuteronomy 4:4)
- For if you strictly keep all this commandment that I am commanding you so as to do it, to love Yehowah your God, to walk in all his ways and to cling to him. (Deuteronomy 11:22)
- And now, please, swear to me by Yehowah that, because I have exercised loving-kindness toward you, you also will certainly exercise loving-kindness toward the household of my father, and you must give me a trustworthy sign. (Joshua 2:12)
- Only be very careful to carry out the commandment and the Law that Moses the servant of Yehowah commanded you by loving Yehowah your God and by walking in all his ways and by keeping his

commandments and by cleaving to him and by serving him with all YOUR heart and with all YOUR soul. (Joshua 22:5)

- But it is to Yehowah YOUR God that YOU should cleave, just as YOU have done down to this day. (Joshua 23:8)
- And Ruth proceeded to say; Do not plead with me to abandon you, to turn back from accompanying you, for where you go I shall go, and where you spend the night I shall spend the night. Your people will be my people, and your God my God. (Ruth 1:16)
- And Samuel proceeded to say to all the house of Israel; If it is with all your heart you are returning to Yehowah, put away the foreign gods from your midst and also the Ashtoreth images, and direct your heart unswervingly to Yehowah and serve him alone, and he will deliver you from the hand of the Philistines. (1 Samuel 7:3)
- And, look! I shall send the attendant, saying; Go, find the arrows. If I should specifically say to the attendant, Look! The arrows are on this side of you, take them, then you come, for it means peace for you and there is nothing the matter, as Yehowah is living. (1 Samuel 20:21)
- And he kept sticking to Yehowah. He did not turn aside from following him, but he continued keeping his commandments that Yehowah had commanded Moses. (2 Kings 18:6)
- As God lives, who has taken away my judgment, and as the Almighty lives, who has made my soul bitter. (Job 27:2)
- I have put you under oath, O daughters of Jerusalem, that, if you find my dear one, you should tell him that I am lovesick. (Song of Solomon 5:8)
- In that day there will prove to be five cities in the land of Egypt speaking the language of Canaan and swearing to Yehowah of armies. The City of Tearing Down will one city be called. (Isaiah 19:18)
- And if you will certainly swear; As Yehowah is alive in truth, in justice and in righteousness! then in him the nations will actually bless themselves, and in him they will boast about themselves. (Jeremiah 4:2)
- And it must occur that if they will without fail learn the ways of my people in swearing by my name, As Yehowah is alive! Just as they taught my people to swear by Baal, they will also be built up in the midst of my people. (Jeremiah 12:16)
