- For he **will** hide me in his covert in the day of calamity, he **will** conceal me in the **secret place** of his tent, high on a rock he **will** put me. (**Psalms 27:5**)
- You **will** conceal them in the **secret place** of your person from the banding together of men. You **will** hide them in your booth from the quarreling of tongues. (**Psalms 31:20**)
- You are a **place** of concealment for me, you **will** safeguard me from distress itself. With joyful cries at providing escape you **will** surround me. (**Psalms 32:7**)
- That people may know that you, whose name is Yehowah, you alone are the **Most High** over all the earth. (**Psalms 83:18**)
- How precious your loving-kindness is, O God! And in the **shadow** of your wings the sons of men themselves take refuge. (**Psalms 36:7**)
- Show me favor, O God, show me favor, for in you my soul has taken refuge, and in the **shadow** of your wings I take refuge until the adversities pass over. (**Psalms 57:1**)
- O Yehowah, you yourself have proved to be a real **dwelling** for us during generation after generation. (**Psalms 90:1**)
- Yehowah is guarding you. Yehowah is your shade on your right hand. (**Psalms 121:5**)
- Deliver me from my enemies, O Yehowah. I have taken cover even with you. (**Psalms 143:9**)

- And there **will** come to be a booth for a shade by day from the dry heat, and for a refuge and for a hiding **place** from the rainstorm and from the precipitation. (**Isaiah 4:6**)
- Look! God is my salvation. I shall trust and be in no dread, for Yah, Yehowah is my strength and my might, and he came to be the salvation of me. (**Isaiah 12:2**)
- And he proceeded to make my mouth like a sharp sword. In the **shadow** of his hand he has hidden me. And he gradually made me a polished arrow. He concealed me in his own quiver. (**Isaiah 49:2**)
- And I shall put my words in your mouth, and with the **shadow** of my hand I shall certainly cover you, in order to plant the heavens and lay the foundation of the earth and say to Zion, You are my people. (**Isaiah 51:16**)
- All those finding them have eaten them up, and their own adversaries have said; We shall not become guilty, due to the fact that they have sinned against Yehowah the abiding **place** of righteousness and the hope of their forefathers, Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 50:7**)
- At that time Nebuchadnezzar the king himself became frightened and he rose up in a hurry. He was answering and saying to his high royal officials; Was it not three able-bodied men that we threw bound into the midst of the fire? They were answering and saying to the king; Yes, O king. (**Daniel 3:24**)
