Revelation 11:18" But the nations became wrathful, and your own wrath came, and the appointed time for the dead to be judged, and to give their reward to your slaves the prophets and to the holy ones and to those fearing your name, the small and the great, and to bring to ruin those ruining the earth.

- Because the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a commanding call, with an archangel's voice and with God's trumpet, and those who are dead in union with Christ will rise first. (1 Thessalonians 4:16)
- Moreover, without faith it is impossible to please him well, for he that approaches God must believe that he is and that he becomes the rewarder of those earnestly seeking him. (Hebrews 11:6)
- And I heard a voice out of heaven say; Write; Happy are the dead who die in union with the Lord from this time onward. Yes, says the spirit, let them rest from their labors, for the things they did go right with them. (Revelation 14:13)
- And I spoke to the prophets, and visions I myself multiplied, and by the hand of the prophets I kept making likenesses. (Hosea 12:10)
- For the Sovereign Lord Yehowah will not do a thing unless he has revealed his confidential matter to his servants the prophets. (Amos 3:7)
- And came and dwelt in a city named Nazareth, that there might be fulfilled what was spoken through the prophets; He will be called a Nazarene. (Matthew 2:23)
- But in this way God has fulfilled the things he announced beforehand through the mouth of all the prophets, that his Christ would suffer. (Acts of Apostles 3:18)
- Which he promised aforetime through his prophets in the holy Scriptures. (Romans 1:2)

- God, who long ago spoke on many occasions and in many ways to our forefathers by means of the prophets. (Hebrews 1:1)
- Brothers, take as a pattern of the suffering of evil and the exercising of patience the prophets, who spoke in the name of Yehowah. (James 5:10)
- Concerning this very salvation a diligent inquiry and a careful search were made by the prophets who prophesied about the undeserved kindness meant for you. (1 Peter 1:10)
- He will bless those fearing Yehowah, the small ones as well as the great ones. (Psalms 115:13)
- However, because I have obtained the help that is from God I continue to this day bearing witness to both small and great, but saying nothing except things the Prophets as well as Moses stated were going to take place. (Acts of Apostles 26:22)
- At this I said; How long, O Yehowah? Then he said; Until the cities actually crash in ruins, to be without an inhabitant, and the houses be without earthling man, and the ground itself is ruined into a desolation. (Isaiah 6:11)
- He has gone up as a lion out of his thicket, and the one who is bringing the nations to ruin has pulled away, he has gone forth from his place in order to render your land as an object of astonishment. Your own cities will fall in ruins so that there will be no inhabitant. (Jeremiah 4:7)
- Micah of Moresheth himself happened to be prophesying in the days of Hezekiah the king of Judah and went on to say to all the people of Judah, This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Zion herself will be plowed up as a mere field, and Jerusalem herself will become mere heaps of ruins, and the mountain of the House will be for high places of a forest. (Jeremiah 26:18)
- Therefore on account of You men Zion will be plowed up as a mere field, and Jerusalem herself will become mere heaps of ruins, and the mountain of the house will be as the high places of a forest. (Micah 3:12)
- And the earth came to be ruined in the sight of the true God and the earth became filled with violence. (Genesis 6:11)

- The senseless one has said in his heart; There is no Yehowah. They have acted ruinously and have acted detestably in unrighteousness, there is no one doing good. (Psalms 53:1)
- All of them are the most stubborn men, walking about as slanderers, copper and iron. They are all of them ruinous. (Jeremiah 6:28)
- Here I am against you, O ruinous mountain, is the utterance of Yehowah, you ruiner of the whole earth, and I will stretch out my hand against you and roll you away from the crags and make you a burnt-out mountain. (Jeremiah 51:25)
- I said, Surely you will fear me, you will accept discipline, so that her dwelling might not be cut off, all that I must call to account against her. Truly they acted promptly in making all their dealings ruinous. (Zephaniah 3:7)
- So God saw the earth and, look! It was ruined, because all flesh had ruined its way on the earth. (Genesis 6:12)
- The rod of your strength Yehowah will send out of Zion, saying; Go subduing in the midst of your enemies. (Psalms 110:2)
- Yehowah himself at your right hand will certainly break kings to pieces on the day of his anger. (Psalms 110:5)
- I myself have said in my heart; The true God will judge both the righteous one and the wicked one, for there is a time for every affair and concerning every work there. (Ecclesiastes 3:17)
- The haughty eyes of earthling man must become low, and the loftiness of men must bow down, and Yehowah alone must be put on high in that day. (Isaiah 2:11)
- And Yehowah actually removes earthling men far away, and the deserted condition does become very extensive in the midst of the land. (Isaiah 6:12)
- His hand he has stretched out over the sea, he has caused kingdoms to be agitated. Yehowah himself has given a command against Phoenicia, to annihilate her strongholds. (Isaiah 23:11)
- The highways have been made desolate, the one passing over the path has ceased. He has broken the covenant, he has contemned the cities, he has taken no account of mortal man. (Isaiah 33:8)

- Saying; Surely in Yehowah there are full righteousness and strength. All those getting heated up against him will come straight to him and be ashamed. (Isaiah 45:24)
- He will likewise startle many nations. At him kings will shut their mouth, because what had not been recounted to them they will actually see, and to what they had not heard they must turn their consideration. (Isaiah 52:15)
- And her dependent towns that are in the field, by the sword they will be killed, and people will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 26:6)
- And I will scatter the Egyptians among the nations and disperse them among the lands, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 30:26)
- And his power must become mighty, but not by his own power. And in a wonderful way he will cause ruin, and he will certainly prove successful and do effectively. And he will actually bring mighty ones to ruin, also the people made up of the holy ones. (Daniel 8:24)
- But according to your hardness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath and of the revealing of God's righteous judgment. (Romans 2:5)
- Do not be afraid of the things you are about to suffer. Look! The Devil will keep on throwing some of you into prison that you may be fully put to the test, and that you may have tribulation ten days. Prove yourself faithful even to death, and I will give you the crown of life. (Revelation 2:10)
- He will also drink of the wine of the anger of God that is poured out undiluted into the cup of his wrath, and he shall be tormented with fire and sulphur in the sight of the holy angels and in the sight of the Lamb. (Revelation 14:10)
