

**Revelation 11:3** **And I will cause my two witnesses to prophesy a thousand two hundred and sixty days dressed in sackcloth.**

- **Also, in YOUR own Law it is written: The witness of two men is true. (John 8:17)**
- **And in the last days, God says, I shall pour out some of my spirit upon every sort of flesh, and YOUR sons and YOUR daughters will prophesy and YOUR young men will see visions and YOUR old men will dream dreams. (Acts of Apostles 2:17)**
- **At that I fell down before his feet to worship him. But he tells me; Be careful! Do not do that! All I am is a fellow slave of you and of your brothers who have the work of witnessing to Jesus. Worship God, for the bearing witness to Jesus is what inspires prophesying. (Revelation 19:10)**
- **When I made sackcloth my clothing, then I became to them a proverbial saying; (Psalms 69:11)**
- **So his servants said to him; Here, now, we have heard that the kings of the house of Israel are kings of loving-kindness. Please, let us carry sackcloth upon our loins and ropes upon our heads, and let us go out to the king of Israel. Perhaps he will preserve your soul alive. (1 Kings 20:31)**
- **At that time Yehowah spoke by the hand of Isaiah the son of Amoz, saying; Go, and you must loosen the sackcloth from off your hips, and your sandals you should draw from off your feet. And he proceeded to do so, walking about naked and barefoot. (Isaiah 20:2)**
- **O woman afflicted, tempest-tossed, uncomforted, here I am laying with hard mortar your stones, and I will lay your foundation with sapphires. (Isaiah 54:11)**
- **And he will speak even words against the Most High, and he will harass continually the holy ones themselves of the Supreme One. And he will intend to change times and law, and they will be given into his hand for a time, and times and half a time. (Daniel 7:25)**

- **Accordingly he said; These are the **two** anointed ones who are standing alongside the Lord of the whole earth. (**Zechariah 4:14**)**
- **And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, that they should feed her there a **thousand two hundred** and **sixty days**. (**Revelation 12:6**)**
- **So down the great dragon was hurled, the original serpent, the one called Devil and Satan, who is misleading the entire inhabited earth, he was hurled down to the earth, and his angels were hurled down with him. (**Revelation 12:9**)**
- **But the **two** wings of the great eagle were given the woman, that she might fly into the wilderness to her place, there is where she is fed for a time and times and half a time away from the face of the serpent. (**Revelation 12:14**)**
