- Then Jezebel his wife said to him; Is it you that now exercise the kingship over Israel? Rise up, eat bread and let your heart be merry. I myself shall give you the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite. (**1 Kings 21:7**)
- Accordingly she wrote letters in Ahab's name and sealed them with his seal, and sent the letters to the older men and the nobles that were in his city dwelling with Naboth. (**1 Kings 21:8**)
- But she wrote in the letters, saying; Proclaim a fast, and **HAVE** Naboth sit at the head of the people. (**1 Kings 21:9**)
- And **MAKE** two men, good-for-nothing fellows, sit in front of him, and let them bear witness against him, saying; You **have** cursed God and the king! And **BRING** him out and stone him that he may die. (**1 Kings 21:10**)
- At that moment the fingers of a man's hand came forth and were writing in front of the lampstand upon the plaster of the wall of the palace of the king, and the king was beholding the back of the hand that was writing. (**Daniel 5:5**)
- This is the interpretation of the word; **MENE**, God has numbered the **days** of your kingdom and has finished it. (**Daniel 5:26**)
- **TEKEL**, you **have** been weighed in the balances and **have** been found deficient. (**Daniel 5:27**)
- **PERES**, your kingdom has been divided and given to the Medes and the Persians. (**Daniel 5:28**)
- At that time Belshazzar commanded, and they clothed Daniel with purple, with a necklace of gold about his neck, and they heralded concerning him that he was to become the third ruler in the kingdom. (**Daniel 5:29**)

- In that very night Belshazzar the Chaldean king was killed. **(Daniel 5:30)**
- And I heard the angel over the **waters** say; You, the One who is and who was, the loyal One, are righteous, because you **have** rendered these decisions. **(Revelation 16:5)**
- Because they poured out the **blood** of holy ones and of prophets, and you **have** given them **blood** to drink. They deserve it. **(Revelation 16:6)**
- And I heard the altar say; Yes, Yehowah God, the Almighty, true and righteous are your judicial decisions. **(Revelation 16:7)**
- Therefore their way will become for them like slippery places in the gloom, into which they will be pushed and certainly fall. For I shall bring upon them a calamity, the year of their being given attention, is the utterance of Yehowah. **(Jeremiah 23:12)**
- For instance, I tell **you** in truth, there were many widows in Israel in the **days** of Elijah, when the **heaven** was **shut** up three years and six months, so that a great famine fell upon all the land. **(Luke 4:25)**
- And Elijah the Tishbite from the inhabitants of Gilead proceeded to say to Ahab; As Yehowah the God of Israel before whom I do stand is living, there will occur during these years neither dew nor **rain**, except at the order of my word! **(1 Kings 17:1)**
- Elijah was a man with feelings like ours, and yet in prayer he prayed for it not to **rain**, and it did not **rain** upon the land for three years and six months. **(James 5:17)**
- Only flesh with its soul, its **blood**, **you** must not eat. **(Genesis 9:4)**
- Subsequently Yehowah said to Moses; Say to Aaron; Take your rod and stretch your hand out over the **waters** of Egypt, over their rivers, over their Nile canals and over their reedy pools and over all their impounded **waters**, that they may become blood. And there will certainly be **blood** in all the land of Egypt and in the wooden vessels and in the stone vessels. **(Exodus 7:19)**
- But to write them to abstain from things polluted by idols and from fornication and from what is strangled and from **blood**. **(Acts of Apostles 15:20)**

- **And the water will certainly be dried up from the sea, and the river itself will become parched and actually run dry. (Isaiah 19:5)**
- **At length it occurred in the twelfth year, in the tenth month, on the fifth day of the month of our exile, that there came to me the escaped one from Jerusalem, saying; The city has been struck down! (Ezekiel 33:21)**
