

**Revelation 13:10**· If anyone is meant for captivity, he goes away into captivity. If anyone will kill with the sword, he must be killed with the sword. Here is where it means the endurance and faith of the holy ones.

[13] - References:

- And I shall certainly gather all the nations against Jerusalem for the war, and the city will actually be captured and the houses be pillaged, and the women themselves will be raped. And half of the city must go forth into the exile, but as for the remaining ones of the people, they will not be cut off from the city. (Zechariah 14:2)
- Anyone shedding man's blood, by man will his own blood be shed, for in God's image he made man. (Genesis 9:6)
- Then Jesus said to him; Return your sword to its place, for all those who take the sword will perish by the sword. (Matthew 26:52)
- But he that has endured to the end is the one that will be saved. (Matthew 24:13)
- For you have need of endurance, in order that, after you have done the will of God, you may receive the fulfillment of the promise. (Hebrews 10:36)
- And another sign was seen in heaven, and, look! A great fiery-colored dragon, with seven heads and ten horns and upon its heads seven diadems. (Revelation 12:3)
- Do not be afraid of the things you are about to suffer. Look! The Devil will keep on throwing some of you into prison that you may be fully put to the test, and that you may have tribulation ten days. Prove yourself faithful even to death, and I will give you the crown of life. (Revelation 2:10)
- But the holy ones of the Supreme One will receive the kingdom, and they will take possession of the kingdom for time indefinite, even for time indefinite upon times indefinite. (Daniel 7:18)
- Or do you not know that the holy ones will judge the world? And if the world is to be judged by you, are you unfit to try very trivial matters? (1 Corinthians 6:2)

- Happy and **holy** is **anyone** having part in the first resurrection, over these the second death has no authority, but they **will** be priests of God and of the Christ, and **will** rule as kings with him for the thousand years. (**Revelation 20:6**)
- And their very children **will** be dashed to pieces before their eyes. Their houses **will** be pillaged, and their own wives **will** be raped. (**Isaiah 13:16**)
- And his power **must** become mighty, but not by his own power. And in a wonderful way he **will** cause ruin, and he **will** certainly prove successful and do effectively. And he **will** actually bring mighty **ones** to ruin, also the people made up of the **holy ones**. (**Daniel 8:24**)
- Here is where it **means endurance** for the **holy ones**, those who observe the commandments of God and the **faith** of Jesus. (**Revelation 14:12**)
