Revelation 14:20. And the winepress was trodden outside the city, and blood came out of the winepress as high up as the bridles of the horses, for a distance of a thousand six hundred furlongs. 1

Footnote: About 296 kilometers (184 miles) A furlong corresponded with a stadium, and equaled one eighth of a Roman mile, 185 meters (606.75 English feet)
