Revelation 14:7" Saying in a loud voice; FEAR God and give him glory, because the hour of the judgment by him has arrived, and so worship the One who made the heaven and the earth and sea and fountains of waters.

- And I saw in the right hand of the One seated upon the throne a scroll written within and on the reverse side, sealed tight with seven seals. (Revelation 5:1)
- And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice; Who is worthy to open the scroll and loose its seals? (Revelation 5:2)
- But neither in heaven nor upon earth nor underneath the earth was there a single one able to open the scroll or to look into it. (Revelation 5:3)
- And I gave way to a great deal of weeping because no one was found worthy to open the scroll or to look into it. (Revelation 5:4)
- But one of the elders says to me; Stop weeping. Look! The Lion that is of the tribe of Judah, the root of David, has conquered so as to open the scroll and its seven seals. (Revelation 5:5)
- The fear of Yehowah means the hating of bad. Self-exaltation and pride and the bad way and the perverse mouth I have hated. (Proverbs 8:13)
- And do not become fearful of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul, but rather be in fear of him that can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna. (Matthew 10:28)
- The heavens are declaring the glory of God, and of the work of his hands the expanse is telling. (Psalms 19:1)
- Because from him and by him and for him are all things. To him be the glory forever. Amen. (Romans 11:36)
- To the only God our Savior through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, might and authority for all past eternity and now and into all eternity. Amen. (Jude 1:25)

- And whenever the living creatures offer glory and honor and thanksgiving to the one seated upon the throne, the one that lives forever and ever. (Revelation 4:9)
- For it is the appointed time for the judgment to start with the house of God. Now if it starts first with us, what will the end be of those who are not obedient to the Good News of God? (1 Peter 4:17)
- Yehowah knows how to deliver people of godly devotion out of trial, but to reserve unrighteous people for the day of judgment to be cut off. (2 Peter 2:9)
- For in six days Yehowah made the heavens and the earth, the sea and everything that is in them, and he proceeded to rest on the seventh day. That is why Yehowah blessed the Sabbath day and proceeded to make it sacred. (Exodus 20:11)
- Our help is in the name of Yehowah, the Maker of heaven and earth. (Psalms 124:8)
- The Maker of heaven and earth, of the sea, and of all that is in them, the One keeping trueness to time indefinite. (Psalms 146:6)
- And saying; Men, why are you doing these things? We also are humans having the same infirmities as you do, and are declaring the Good News to you, for you to turn from these vain things to the living God, who made the heaven and the earth and the sea and all the things in them. (Acts of Apostles 14:15)
- Then may you yourself listen from the heavens, from your established place of dwelling, and you must do according to all for which the foreigner calls to you, in order that all the peoples of the earth may know your name and may fear you the same as your people Israel do, and may know that your name has been called upon this house that I have built. (2 Chronicles 6:33)
- You are Yehowah alone, you yourself have made the heavens, even the heaven of the heavens, and all their army, the earth and all that is upon it, the seas and all that is in them, and you are preserving all of them alive, and the army of the heavens are bowing down to you. (Nehemiah 9:6)
- Let all those of the earth be in fear of Yehowah. At him let all the inhabitants of the productive land be frightened. (Psalms 33:8)

- O come in, let us worship and bow down, let us kneel before Yehowah our Maker. (Psalms 95:6)
- In that case you will understand the fear of Yehowah, and you will find the very knowledge of God. (Proverbs 2:5)
- But I will indicate to You whom to fear. Fear him who after killing has authority to throw into Gehenna. Yes, I tell You, fear this One. (Luke 12:5)
- Therefore, since we have these promises, beloved ones, let us cleanse ourselves of every defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in God's fear. (2 Corinthians 7:1)
- You are worthy, Yehowah, even our God, to receive the glory and the honor and the power, because you created all things, and because of your will they existed and were created. (Revelation 4:11)
- And the men were scorched with great heat, but they blasphemed the name of God, who has the authority over these plagues, and they did not repent so as to give glory to him. (Revelation 16:9)
