

**Revelation 16:1**· **And I heard a loud voice out of the sanctuary say to the seven angels; Go and pour out the seven bowls of the anger of God into the earth.**

[10] - References:

- Concerning that day and hour nobody knows, neither the **angels** of the heavens nor the Son, but only the Father. (**Matthew 24:36**)
- There is a sound of uproar **out** of the city, a sound **out** of the temple! It is the sound of Yehowah repaying what is deserved to his enemies. (**Isaiah 66:6**)
- And the seventh one poured **out** his bowl upon the air. At this a **loud voice** issued **out** of the **sanctuary** from the throne, saying; It has come to pass! (**Revelation 16:17**)
- Pour **out** upon them your denunciation, and may your own burning **anger** overtake them. (**Psalms 69:24**)
- Therefore keep yourselves in expectation of me, is the utterance of Yehowah, till the day of my rising up to the booty, for my judicial decision is to gather nations, for me to collect together kingdoms, in order to **pour out** upon them my denunciation, all my burning **anger**, for by the fire of my zeal all the earth will be devoured. (**Zephaniah 3:8**)
- Pour **out** your rage upon the nations who have ignored you, and upon the families who have not called even upon your name. For they have eaten up Jacob. Yes, they have eaten him up, and they keep at exterminating him, and his abiding place they have desolated. (**Jeremiah 10:25**)
- And I began to hear someone speaking to me **out** of the House, and the man himself had come to be standing beside me. (**Ezekiel 43:6**)
- In the face of his denunciation who can stand? And who can rise up against the heat of his **anger**? His own rage will certainly be poured **out** like fire, and the very rocks will actually be pulled down because of him. (**Nahum 1:6**)
- And I saw in heaven another sign, great and wonderful, **seven angels** with **seven** plagues. These are the last ones, because by

means of them the **anger of God** is brought to a finish.  
(**Revelation 15:1**)

- And one of the **seven angels** that had the **seven bowls** came and spoke with me, saying; Come, I will show you the judgment upon the great harlot who sits on many waters. (**Revelation 17:1**)
