Revelation 16:12. And the sixth one poured out his bowl upon the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, that the way might be prepared for the kings from the rising of the sun.

- This is what Yehowah has said to his anointed one, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have taken hold of, to subdue before him nations, so that I may ungird even the hips of kings, to open before him the two-leaved doors, so that even the gates will not be shut. (Isaiah 45:1)
- And the sixth angel blew his trumpet. And I heard one voice out of the horns of the golden altar that is before God (Revelation 9:13)
- By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down. We also wept when we remembered Zion. (Psalms 137:1)
- The One saying to the watery deep, Be evaporated, and all your rivers I shall dry up. (Isaiah 44:27)
- The One saying of Cyrus; He is my shepherd, and all that I delight in he will completely carry out, even in my saying of Jerusalem, She will be rebuilt, and of the temple, You will have your foundation laid. (Isaiah 44:28)
- There is a devastation upon her waters, and they must be dried up. For it is a land of graven images, and because of their frightful visions they keep acting crazy. (Jeremiah 50:38)
- And I will make her princes and her wise ones, her governors and her deputy rulers and her mighty men drunk, and they must sleep an indefinitely lasting sleep, from which they will not wake up, is the utterance of the King, whose name is Yehowah of armies. (Jeremiah 51:57)
- You were the One that split the spring and the torrent, you yourself dried up ever-flowing rivers. (Psalms 74:15)
- And Yehowah will certainly cut off the tongue of the Egyptian sea, and wave his hand at the River in the glow of his spirit. And

- he must strike it in its seven torrents, and he will actually cause people to walk in their sandals. (Isaiah 11:15)
- So the craftsman went strengthening the metalworker, the one doing the smoothing out with the forge hammer him that is hammering away at the anvil, saying regarding the soldering; It is good. Finally one fastened it with nails that it could not be made to totter. (Isaiah 41:7)
- I have roused up someone from the north, and he will come. From the rising of the sun he will call upon my name. And he will come upon deputy rulers as if they were clay and just as a potter that tramples down the moist material. (Isaiah 41:25)
- And when the chieftain comes in, by the way of the porch of the gate he should come in, and by the way of it he should go out. (Ezekiel 46:8)
- But there will be reports that will disturb him, out of the sunrising and out of the north, and he will certainly go forth in a great rage in order to annihilate and to devote many to destruction. (Daniel 11:44)
- And I saw another angel ascending from the sunrising, having a seal of the living God, and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels to whom it was granted to harm the earth and the sea. (Revelation 7:2)
- Say to the sixth angel, who had the trumpet; Until the four angels that are bound at the great river Euphrates. (Revelation 9:14)
