- **And Jesus approached and spoke to them, saying; All authority has been given me in heaven and on the earth. (Matthew 28:18)**
- **Who really is the faithful and discreet slave whom his master appointed over his domestics, to give them their food at the proper time? (Matthew 24:45)**
- **Happy is that slave if his master on arriving finds him doing so. (Matthew 24:46)**
- **Truly I say to you, he will appoint him over all his belongings. (Matthew 24:47)**
- **But if ever that evil slave should say in his heart; My master is delaying. (Matthew 24:48)**
- **And should start to beat his fellow slaves and should eat and drink with the confirmed drunkards. (Matthew 24:49)**
- **The master of that slave will come on a day that he does not expect and in an hour that he does not know. (Matthew 24:50)**
- **And will punish him with the greatest severity and will assign him his part with the hypocrites. There is where his weeping and the gnashing of his teeth will be. (Matthew 24:51)**
- **And they took no note until the flood came and swept them all away, so the presence of the Son of man will be. (Matthew 24:39)**
- **Then two men will be in the field, one will be taken along and the other be abandoned. (Matthew 24:40)**
- **Two women will be grinding at the hand mill, one will be taken along and the other be abandoned. (Matthew 24:41)**
- **Keep on the watch, therefore, because YOU do not know on what day YOUR Lord is coming. (Matthew 24:42)**

- **Maintain **YOUR** conduct fine among the nations, that, in the thing in which they are speaking against **YOU** as evildoers, they may as a result of **YOUR** fine works of which they are eyewitnesses glorify God in the day for his inspection. (1 Peter 2:12)**
- **And when he got nearby, he viewed the city and wept over it. (Luke 19:41)**
- **Saying; If you, even you, had discerned in this day the things having to do with peace, but now they have been hid from your eyes. (Luke 19:42)**
- **Because the days will come upon you when your enemies will build around you a fortification with pointed stakes and will encircle you and distress you from every side. (Luke 19:43)**
- **And they will dash you and your children within you to the ground, and they will not leave a stone upon a stone in you, because you did not discern the time of your being inspected. (Luke 19:44)**
- **For **you** yourselves know quite well that Yehowah's day is **coming** exactly as a **thief** in the night. (1 Thessalonians 5:2)**
- **Yet Yehowah's day will come as a **thief**, in which the heavens will pass away with a hissing noise, but the elements being intensely hot will be dissolved, and earth and the works in it will be discovered. (2 Peter 3:10)**
- **Keep **awake**, then, all the time making supplication that **you** may succeed in escaping all these things that are destined to occur, and in standing before the Son of man. (Luke 21:36)**
- **I advise you to buy from me gold refined by fire that you may become rich, and white **outer garments** that you may become dressed and that the shame of your nakedness may not become manifested, and eyesalve to rub in your eyes that you may see. (Revelation 3:18)**
- **The pronouncement against Dumah; To me there is one calling out from Seir; Watchman, what about the night? Watchman, what about the night? (Isaiah 21:11)**
- **And to them the word of Yehowah will certainly become, command upon command, command upon command, measuring line upon measuring line, measuring line upon measuring line,**

- here a little, there a little, in order that they may go and certainly stumble backwards and actually be broken and ensnared and caught. (**Isaiah 28:13**)
- Tremble, **you** women who are at ease! Be agitated, **you** careless ones! Undress and make yourselves **naked**, and gird sackcloth upon the loins. (**Isaiah 32:11**)
 - Why is it that, when I came in, there was no one? When I called, there was nobody answering? Has my hand become in fact so short that it cannot redeem, or is there in me no power to deliver? Look! With my rebuke I dry up the sea, I make rivers a wilderness. Their fish stink due to there being no water, and they die because of thirst. (**Isaiah 50:2**)
 - His watchmen are blind. None of them have taken note. All of them are speechless dogs, they are not able to bark, panting, lying down, loving to slumber. (**Isaiah 56:10**)
 - We keep groaning, all of us, just like bears, and like doves we mournfully keep cooing. We kept hoping for justice, but there was none, for salvation, but it has stayed far away from us. (**Isaiah 59:11**)
 - The spirit of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah is upon me, for the reason that Yehowah has anointed me to tell Good News to the meek ones. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to those taken captive and the wide opening of the eyes even to the prisoners. (**Isaiah 61:1**)
 - And I will give you into their hand, and they will certainly tear down your mound and your heights will certainly be pulled down, and they must strip you of your **garments** and take your beautiful articles and leave you behind **naked** and nude. (**Ezekiel 16:39**)
 - And they will certainly strip off you your **garments** and take away your beautiful articles. (**Ezekiel 23:26**)
 - And the sons of your **people** have said; The way of Yehowah is not adjusted right, but, as for them, it is their way that is not adjusted right. (**Ezekiel 33:17**)
 - **Happy** is that slave if his master on arriving finds him doing so. (**Matthew 24:46**)

- **Keep on the watch and pray continually, that **you** may not enter into temptation. The spirit, of course, is eager, but the flesh is weak. (Matthew 26:41)**
- **But know this, that if the householder had known at what hour the **thief** would come, he would have kept watching and not have let his house be broken into. (Luke 12:39)**
- **To the angel of the congregation in Ephesus write; These are the things that he says who holds the seven stars in his right hand, he who **walks** in the midst of the seven golden lampstands. (Revelation 2:1)**
- **Therefore, continue mindful of how you have received and how you heard, and go on keeping it, and repent. Certainly unless you wake up, I shall come as a **thief**, and you will not know at all at what hour I shall come upon you. (Revelation 3:3)**
- **And I saw another strong angel descending from heaven, arrayed with a cloud, and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as the sun, and his feet were as fiery pillars. (Revelation 10:1)**
- **And, **look!** I **am coming** quickly. **Happy** is anyone observing the words of the prophecy of this scroll. (Revelation 22:7)**
