- And I saw in heaven another sign, **great** and wonderful, seven angels with seven plagues. These are the last ones, because by means of them the anger of God is brought to a finish. (**Revelation 15:1**)
- Also, there will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the **earth** anguish of nations, not knowing the way out because of the roaring of the sea and its agitation. (**Luke 21:25**)
- While **men** become faint out of fear and expectation of the things coming upon the inhabited **earth**, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. (**Luke 21:26**)
- And then they will see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and **great** glory. (**Luke 21:27**)
- But as these things start to occur, raise yourselves erect and lift **YOUR** heads up, because **YOUR** deliverance is getting near. (**Luke 21:28**)
- And in my ardor, in the fire of my fury, I shall have to speak. Surely in that day a **great** quaking will occur in the soil of Israel. (**Ezekiel 38:19**)
- And during that time Michael will stand up, the **great** prince who is standing in behalf of the sons of your people. And there will certainly occur a time of distress **such** as has not been made to occur since there **came** to be a nation until that time. And during that time your people will escape, every one who is found written down in the book. (**Daniel 12:1**)
- At that time his voice shook the **earth**, but now he has promised, saying; Yet once more I will set in commotion not only the **earth** but also the heaven. (**Hebrews 12:26**)
- And the **earth** began to shake and rock, and the foundations of the mountains themselves became agitated, and they kept shaking back and forth because he had been angered. (**Psalms 18:7**)

- **And people will enter into the caves of the rocks and into the holes of the dust because of the dreadfulness of Yehowah and from his splendid superiority, when he rises up for the earth to suffer shocks. (Isaiah 2:19)**
