[7] - References:

- **And I used to appear to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob as **God Almighty**, but as respects my name Yehowah I did not make myself known to them. (**Exodus 6:3**)**
- **The fear of Yehowah is pure, standing forever. The **judicial** decisions of Yehowah are **true**, they have proved altogether **righteous**. (**Psalms 19:9**)**
- **You are **righteous**, O Yehowah, and your **judicial** decisions are upright. (**Psalms 119:137**)**
- **Because his judgments are **true** and **righteous**. For he has executed judgment upon the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication, and he has avenged the blood of his slaves at her hand. (**Revelation 19:2**)**
- **When Abram got to be ninety-nine years old, then Yehowah appeared to Abram and said to him; I am **God Almighty**. Walk before me and prove yourself faultless. (**Genesis 17:1**)**
- **This is a proof of the **righteous** judgment of **God**, leading to **YOUR** being counted worthy of the kingdom of **God**, for which **YOU** are indeed suffering. (**2 Thessalonians 1:5**)**
- **Saying; We thank you, Yehowah **God**, the **Almighty**, the One who is and who was, because you have taken your great power and begun ruling as king. (**Revelation 11:17**)**
