Revelation 16:9" And the men were scorched with great heat, but they blasphemed the name of God, who has the authority over these plagues, and they did not repent so as to give glory to him.

- But right away the angel took the incense vessel, and he filled it with some of the fire of the altar and hurled it to the earth. And thunders occurred and voices and lightnings and an earthquake. (Revelation 8:5)
- That people may know that you, whose name is Yehowah, you alone are the Most High over all the earth. (Psalms 83:18)
- Let every soul be in subjection to the superior authorities, for there is no authority except by God, the existing authorities stand placed in their relative positions by God. (Romans 13:1)
- And they did not repent of their murders nor of their spiritistic practices nor of their fornication nor of their thefts. (Revelation 9:21)
- Saying in a loud voice; FEAR God and give him glory, because the hour of the judgment by him has arrived, and so worship the One who made the heaven and the earth and sea and fountains of waters. (Revelation 14:7)
- And the son of the Israelite woman began to abuse the Name and to call down evil upon it. So they brought him to Moses. Incidentally, his mother's name was Shelomith, the daughter of Dibri of the tribe of Dan. (Leviticus 24:11)
- While he was yet speaking with them, here was the messenger coming down to him, and the king proceeded to say; Here this is the calamity from Yehowah. Why should I wait any longer for Yehowah? (2 Kings 6:33)
- It is the foolishness of an earthling man that distorts his way, and so his heart becomes enraged against Yehowah himself. (Proverbs 19:3)
- And it was granted the locusts, not to kill them, but that these should be tormented five months, and the torment upon them was as torment by a scorpion when it strikes a man. (Revelation 9:5)

And a great hail with every stone about the weight of a talent descended out of heaven upon the men, and the men blasphemed God due to the plague of hail, because the plague of it was unusually great. (Revelation 16:21)
