- **And I heard a loud voice out of the sanctuary say to the seven angels; Go and pour out the seven bowls of the anger of God into the earth. (Revelation 16:1)**
- **Do YOU not know that YOUR bodies are members of Christ? Shall I, then, take the members of the Christ away and make them members of a harlot? Never may that happen! (1 Corinthians 6:15)**
- **Adulteresses, do YOU not know that the friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever, therefore, wants to be a friend of the world is constituting himself an enemy of God. (James 4:4)**
- **But the wicked are like the sea that is being tossed, when it is unable to calm down, the waters of which keep tossing up seaweed and mire. (Isaiah 57:20)**
- **O woman residing on abounding waters, abundant in treasures, your end has come, the measure of your profit making. (Jeremiah 51:13)**
