- So they said to one another; Look! Here comes that dreamer. (**Genesis 37:19**)
- And now come and let us kill him and pitch him into one of the water-pits, and we must say a vicious wild beast devoured him. Then let us see what will become of his dreams. (**Genesis 37:20**)
- Now men, Midianite merchants, went passing by. Hence they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the water-pit and then sold Joseph to the Ishmaelites for twenty silver pieces. Eventually these brought Joseph into Egypt. (**Genesis 37:28**)
- Yes, in her was found the **blood** of prophets and of **holy ones** and of all those who have been slaughtered on the earth. (**Revelation 18:24**)
- Because his judgments are true and righteous. For he has executed judgment upon the **great** harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication, and he has avenged the **blood** of his slaves at her hand. (**Revelation 19:2**)
- And when he opened the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of those slaughtered because of the word of God and because of the witness work that they used to have. (**Revelation 6:9**)
- For they have fed themselves with the bread of wickedness, and the wine of acts of violence is what they drink. (**Proverbs 4:17**)
- Therefore listen to this, please, O **woman** afflicted and **drunk**, but not with wine. (**Isaiah 51:21**)
- They were the **ones** that uncovered her nakedness. Her sons and her daughters they took, and her they killed even with sword. And she came to be infamy to women, and acts of judgment were what they executed upon her. (**Ezekiel 23:10**)

- **Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Woe to the city of deeds of bloodshed! I myself also shall make the pile **great**. (Ezekiel 24:9)**
- **I myself, Yehowah, have spoken. It must come, and I will act. I shall not neglect, neither shall I feel sorry nor feel regret. According to your ways and according to your dealings they will certainly judge you, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 24:14)**
- **And in Moab I shall execute acts of judgment, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 25:11)**
- **And I will make you a shining, bare surface of a crag. A drying yard for dragnets is what you will become. Never will you be rebuilt, for I myself, Yehowah, have spoken, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 26:14)**
- **And you must say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am against you, O Sidon, and I shall certainly be glorified in the midst of you, and people will have to know that I am Yehowah when I execute acts of judgment in her and I am actually sanctified in her. (Ezekiel 28:22)**
- **And he will speak even words against the Most High, and he will harass continually the **holy ones** themselves of the Supreme One. And he will intend to change times and law, and they will be given into his hand for a time, and times and half a time. (Daniel 7:25)**
