- **Therefore hear the word of Yehowah, YOU braggarts, YOU rulers of this people who are in Jerusalem. (Isaiah 28:14)**
- **Because YOU men have said; We have concluded a covenant with Death, and with Sheol we have effected a vision, the overflowing flash flood, in case it should pass through, will not come to us, for we have made a lie our refuge and in falsehood we have concealed ourselves. (Isaiah 28:15)**
- **Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am laying as a foundation in Zion a stone, a tried stone, the precious corner of a sure foundation. No one exercising faith will get panicky. (Isaiah 28:16)**
- **And I will make justice the measuring line and righteousness the leveling instrument, and the hail must sweep away the refuge of a lie, and the waters themselves will flood out the very place of concealment. (Isaiah 28:17)**
- **And YOUR covenant with Death will certainly be dissolved, and that vision of YOURS with Sheol will not stand. The overflowing flash flood, when it passes through, YOU must also become for it a trampling place. (Isaiah 28:18)**
- **As often as it passes through, it will take YOU men away, because morning by morning it will pass through, during the day and during the night, and it must become nothing but a reason for quaking to make others understand what has been heard. (Isaiah 28:19)**
- **But if ever that evil slave should say in his heart, My master is delaying. (Matthew 24:48)**
- **And should start to beat his fellow slaves and should eat and drink with the confirmed drunkards. (Matthew 24:49)**

- The master of that slave **will** come on a day that he does not expect and in an hour that he does not know. (**Matthew 24:50**)
- And **will** punish him with the greatest severity and **will** assign him his part with the hypocrites. There is where his weeping and the gnashing of his teeth **will** be. (**Matthew 24:51**)
- Woe to those who are saying that good is bad and bad is good, those who are putting darkness for light and light for darkness, those who are putting bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter! (**Isaiah 5:20**)
- Woe to those wise in their own eyes and discreet even in front of their own faces! (**Isaiah 5:21**)
- Woe to those who are mighty in drinking wine, and to the men with vital energy for mixing intoxicating liquor. (**Isaiah 5:22**)
- Those who are pronouncing the wicked one righteous in consideration of a bribe, and who take away even the righteousness of the righteous one from him! (**Isaiah 5:23**)
- The exultation of the tambourines has ceased, the noise of the highly elated ones has discontinued, the exultation of the **harp** has ceased. (**Isaiah 24:8**)
- And I **will** cause the turmoil of your singing to cease, and the very **sound** of your **harps will** be **heard** no more. (**Ezekiel 26:13**)
- Down to Sheol your pride has been brought, the din of your stringed instruments. Beneath you, maggots are spread out as a couch, and worms are your covering. (**Isaiah 14:11**)
- Like the heat in a waterless country, the noise of strangers you subdue, the heat with the shadow of a cloud. The melody itself of the tyrannical ones becomes suppressed. (**Isaiah 25:5**)
- And I **will** destroy out of them the **sound** of exultation and the **sound** of rejoicing, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the **sound** of the hand mill and the light of the lamp. (**Jeremiah 25:10**)
- For Yehowah is despoiling Babylon, and he **will** certainly destroy out of her the great voice, and their waves **will** actually be boisterous like many waters. The noise of their voice **will** certainly be given out (**Jeremiah 51:55**)
