

Revelation 18:4 And I heard another voice out of heaven say; **Get out of her, my people, if you do not want to share with her in her sins, and if you do not want to receive part of her plagues.**

[26] - References:

- But if he has doubts, he is already condemned if he eats, because he does not eat **out** of faith. Indeed, everything that is not **out** of faith is sin. (**Romans 14:23**)
- But the one that did not understand and so did things deserving of strokes will be beaten with few. Indeed, everyone to whom much was given, much will be demanded of him, and the one whom **people** put in charge of much, they will demand more than usual of him. (**Luke 12:48**)
- And they took no note until the flood came and swept them all away, so the presence of the Son of man will be. (**Matthew 24:39**)
- Then two men will be in the field, one will be taken along and the other be abandoned. (**Matthew 24:40**)
- Two women will be grinding at the hand mill, one will be taken along and the other be abandoned. (**Matthew 24:41**)
- Keep on the watch, therefore, because **you** do not know on what day **YOUR** Lord is coming. (**Matthew 24:42**)
- Go forth, **you people**, **out** of Babylon! Run away from the Chaldeans. Tell forth even with the sound of a joyful cry, cause this to be heard. Make it to go forth to the extremity of the earth. Say; Yehowah has repurchased his servant Jacob. (**Isaiah 48:20**)
- Turn away, turn away, get **out** of there, touch nothing unclean, get **out** from the midst of her, keep yourselves clean, **you** who are carrying the utensils of Yehowah. (**Isaiah 52:11**)
- Take **YOUR** flight **out** of the midst of Babylon, and go forth even **out** of the land of the Chaldeans, and become like the leading animals before the flock. (**Jeremiah 50:8**)

- Get **out** of the midst of her, O my **people**, and provide each one his soul with escape from the burning anger of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 51:45**)
- Hey there, Zion! Make your escape, you who are dwelling with the daughter of Babylon. (**Zechariah 2:7**)
- **FLEE out** of the midst of Babylon, and provide escape each one for his own soul. Do not be rendered inanimate through her error. For it is the time of vengeance belonging to Yehowah. There is treatment that he is paying back to her. (**Jeremiah 51:6**)
- Therefore get **out** from among them, and separate yourselves, **says** Yehowah, and quit touching the unclean thing, and I will take **you** in. (**2 Corinthians 6:17**)
- Hence Lot went on **out** and began to speak to his sons-in-law who were to take his daughters, and he kept on saying; **Get up!** Get **out** of this place, because Yehowah is bringing the city to ruin! But in the eyes of his sons-in-law he seemed like a man who was joking. (**Genesis 19:14**)
- Separate yourselves from the midst of this assembly, that I may exterminate them in an instant. (**Numbers 16:21**)
- For that is the way he commanded me by the word of Yehowah, saying; You must not eat bread or drink water, and you must not return by the way that you went. (**1 Kings 13:9**)
- Leave the inexperienced ones and keep living, and walk straight in the way of understanding. (**Proverbs 9:6**)
- Cross over to Tarshish, howl, **you** inhabitants of the coastland. (**Isaiah 23:6**)
- Woe to the eminent crown of the drunkards of Ephraim, and the fading blossom of its decoration of beauty that is upon the head of the fertile valley of those overpowered by wine! (**Isaiah 28:1**)
- To **say** to the prisoners, Come out! To those who are in the darkness, Reveal yourselves! By the ways they will pasture, and on all beaten paths their pasturing will be. (**Isaiah 49:9**)
- Shake yourself free from the dust, rise up, take a seat, O Jerusalem. Loosen for yourself the bands on your neck, O captive daughter of Zion. (**Isaiah 52:2**)

- He was despised and was avoided by men, a man meant for pains and for having acquaintance with sickness. And there was as if the concealing of one's face from us. He was despised, and we held him as of no account. (**Isaiah 53:3**)
- The eggs of a poisonous snake are what they have hatched, and they kept weaving the mere cobweb of a spider. Anyone eating some of their eggs would die, and the egg that was smashed would be hatched into a viper. (**Isaiah 59:5**)
- We would have healed Babylon, but she has not been healed. Leave her, **you people**, and let us go each one to his own land. For clear to the **heavens** her judgment has reached, and it has been lifted up to the cloudy skies. (**Jeremiah 51:9**)
- **You** escapees from the sword, keep going. Do not stand still. From far away remember Yehowah, and may Jerusalem herself come up into **YOUR** heart. (**Jeremiah 51:50**)
- Never lay your hands hastily upon any man, neither be a sharer in the **sins** of others, preserve yourself chaste. (**1 Timothy 5:22**)
- The form of worship that is clean and undefiled from the standpoint of our God and Father is this. To look after orphans and widows in their tribulation, and to keep oneself without spot from the world. (**James 1:27**)
- For he that **says** a greeting to him is a sharer in his wicked works. (**2 John 1:11**)
