Revelation 19:11... And I saw the heaven opened, and, look! A white horse.

And the one seated upon it is called Faithful and True, and he judges and carries on war in righteousness.

- This takes into account that it is righteous on God's part to repay tribulation to those who make tribulation for YOU. (2 Thessalonians 1:6)
- But, to you who suffer tribulation, relief along with us at the revelation of the Lord Jesus from heaven with his powerful angels (2 Thessalonians 1:7)
- In a flaming fire, as he brings vengeance upon those who do not know God and those who do not obey the Good News about our Lord Jesus. (2 Thessalonians 1:8)
- These very ones will undergo the judicial punishment of everlasting destruction from before the Lord and from the glory of his strength. (2 Thessalonians 1:9)
- At the time he comes to be glorified in connection with his holy ones and to be regarded in that day with wonder in connection with all those who exercised faith, because the witness we gave met with faith among you. (2 Thessalonians 1:10)
- As soon as the horn blows it says Aha! And from far off it smells the battle, the uproar of chiefs and the war cry. (Job 39:25)
- The horse is something prepared for the day of battle, but salvation belongs to Yehowah. (Proverbs 21:31)
- I have paid attention, and I kept listening. It was not right the way they kept speaking. There was not a man repenting over his badness, saying, What have I done? Each one is going back into the popular course, like a horse that is dashing into the battle. (Jeremiah 8:6)
- And I saw, and, look! A white horse, and the one seated upon it had a bow, and a crown was given him, and he went forth conquering and to complete his conquest. (Revelation 6:2)

- But Christ was faithful as a Son over the house of that One. We are the house of that One, if we make fast our hold on our freeness of speech and our boasting over the hope firm to the end. (Hebrews 3:6)
- And from Jesus Christ, the Faithful Witness, The Firstborn from the dead, and The Ruler of the kings of the earth. To him that loves us and that loosed us from our sins by means of his own blood. (Revelation 1:5)
- So the Word became flesh and resided among us, and we had a view of his glory, a glory such as belongs to an only-begotten son from a father, and he was full of undeserved kindness and truth. (John 1:14)
- And to the angel of the congregation in Laodicea write; These are the things that the Amen says, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation by God. (Revelation 3:14)
- And with righteousness he must judge the lowly ones, and with uprightness he must give reproof in behalf of the meek ones of the earth. And he must strike the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the spirit of his lips he will put the wicked one to death. (Isaiah 11:4)
- But with reference to the Son; God is your throne forever and ever, and the scepter of your kingdom is the scepter of uprightness. (Hebrews 1:8)
- You loved righteousness, and you hated lawlessness. That is why God, your God, anointed you with the oil of exultation more than your partners. (Hebrews 1:9)
- And in your splendor go on to success; Ride in the cause of truth and humility and righteousness, and your right hand will instruct you in fear-inspiring things. (Psalms 45:4)
- Your people will offer themselves willingly on the day of your military force. In the splendors of holiness, from the womb of the dawn, you have your company of young men just like dewdrops. (Psalms 110:3)
- The doing of wickedness is something detestable to kings, for by righteousness is the throne firmly established. (Proverbs 16:12)

- Open your mouth, judge righteously and plead the cause of the afflicted one and the poor one. (Proverbs 31:9)
- Look! A king will reign for righteousness itself, and as respects princes, they will rule as princes for justice itself. (Isaiah 32:1)
- No crushed reed will he break, and as for a dim flaxen wick, he will not extinguish it. In trueness he will bring forth justice. (Isaiah 42:3)
