

Revelation 19:19 And I saw the wild beast and the kings of the earth and their armies gathered together to wage the war with the one seated on the horse and with his army.

[13] - References:

- Why have the nations been in tumult and the national groups themselves kept muttering an empty thing? (**Psalms 2:1**)
- The **kings** of **earth** take their stand and high officials themselves have massed **together** as one against Yehowah and against his anointed one. (**Psalms 2:2**)
- Saying; Let us tear their bands apart and cast their cords away from us! (**Psalms 2:3**)
- The very One sitting in the heavens will laugh, Yehowah himself will hold them in derision. (**Psalms 2:4**)
- At that time he will speak to them in his anger and in his hot displeasure he will disturb them. (**Psalms 2:5**)
- Saying; I, even I, have installed my king upon Zion, my holy mountain. (**Psalms 2:6**)
- Let me refer to the decree of Yehowah, he has said to me You are my son, I, today, I have become your father. (**Psalms 2:7**)
- Ask of me, that I may give nations as your inheritance and the ends of the **earth** as your own possession. (**Psalms 2:8**)
- You will break them with an iron scepter, as though a potter's vessel you will dash them to pieces. (**Psalms 2:9**)
- And now, O **kings**, exercise insight, let yourselves be corrected, O judges of the **earth**. (**Psalms 2:10**)
- Serve Yehowah with fear and be joyful with trembling. (**Psalms 2:11**)
- Kiss the son, that He may not become incensed and **you** may not perish from the way, for his anger flares up easily. Happy are all those taking refuge in him. (**Psalms 2:12**)
- And it stood still upon the sand of the sea. And I saw a **wild beast** ascending out of the sea, with ten horns and seven heads,

- and upon its horns ten diadems, but upon its heads blasphemous names. (**Revelation 13:1**)
- They are, in fact, expressions inspired by demons and perform signs, and they go forth to the **kings** of the entire inhabited **earth**, to gather them **together** to the **war** of the great day of God the Almighty. (**Revelation 16:14**)
 - And the ten horns that you saw mean ten **kings**, who have not yet received a kingdom, but they do receive authority as **kings** one hour with the **wild beast**. (**Revelation 17:12**)
 - And they **gathered** them **together** to the place that is called in Hebrew Har–Magedon. (**Revelation 16:16**)
 - The **kings** of **earth** take their stand and high officials themselves have massed **together** as one against Yehowah and against his anointed one. (**Psalms 2:2**)
 - Your arrows are sharp, under you peoples keep falling; In the heart of the enemies of the king. (**Psalms 45:5**)
 - For, look! The **kings** themselves have met by appointment, they have passed by **together**. (**Psalms 48:4**)
 - Yehowah himself at your right hand will certainly break **kings** to pieces on the day of his anger. (**Psalms 110:5**)
 - And I will put it in the hand of the ones irritating you, who have said to your soul, Bow down that we may cross over, so that you used to make your back just like the **earth**, and like the street for those crossing over. (**Isaiah 51:23**)
 - Crowds, crowds are in the low plain of the decision, for the day of Yehowah is near in the low plain of the decision. (**Joel 3:14**)
 - Therefore keep yourselves in expectation of me, is the utterance of Yehowah, till the day of my rising up to the booty, for my judicial decision is to gather nations, for me to collect **together** kingdoms, in order to pour out upon them my denunciation, all my burning anger, for by the fire of my zeal all the **earth** will be devoured. (**Zephaniah 3:8**)
 - And this Good News of the kingdom will be preached in all the inhabited **earth** for a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come. (**Matthew 24:14**)
