- This takes into account that it is **righteous** on God's part to repay tribulation to those who make tribulation for **you**. (**2 Thessalonians 1:6**)
- But, to **you** who suffer tribulation, relief along with us at the revelation of the Lord Jesus from heaven with his powerful angels (**2 Thessalonians 1:7**)
- In a flaming fire, as he brings vengeance upon those who do not know God and those who do not obey the Good News about our Lord Jesus. (**2 Thessalonians 1:8**)
- These very ones will undergo the judicial punishment of everlasting destruction from before the Lord and from the glory of his strength. (**2 Thessalonians 1:9**)
- At the time he comes to be glorified in connection with his holy ones and to be regarded in that day with wonder in connection with all those who exercised faith, because the witness we gave met with faith among **you**. (**2 Thessalonians 1:10**)
- And I heard the angel over the waters say; You, the One who is and who was, the loyal One, are **righteous**, because you have rendered these decisions. (**Revelation 16:5**)
- Because they poured out the **blood** of holy ones and of prophets, and you have given them **blood** to drink. They deserve it. (**Revelation 16:6**)
- And I heard the altar say; Yes, Yehowah God, the Almighty, **true** and **righteous** are your judicial decisions. (**Revelation 16:7**)

- **The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his ways are justice. A God of faithfulness, with whom there is no injustice. Righteous and upright is he. (Deuteronomy 32:4)**
- **The fear of Yehowah is pure, standing forever. The judicial decisions of Yehowah are true, they have proved altogether righteous. (Psalms 19:9)**
- **Furthermore, if YOU are calling upon the Father who judges impartially according to each one's work, conduct yourselves with fear during the time of YOUR alien residence. (1 Peter 1:17)**
- **And they are singing the song of Moses the slave of God and the song of the Lamb, saying; Great and wonderful are your works, Yehowah God, the Almighty. Righteous and true are your ways, King of eternity. (Revelation 15:3)**
- **Be glad, YOU nations, with his people, for he will avenge the blood of his servants, and he will pay back vengeance to his adversaries and will indeed make atonement for the ground of his people. (Deuteronomy 32:43)**
- **And you must strike down the house of Ahab your lord, and I must avenge the blood of my servants the prophets and the blood of all the servants of Yehowah at the hand of Jezebel. (2 Kings 9:7)**
- **Why should the nations say; Where is their God? Among the nations let there be known before our eyes the avenging of the blood of your servants that has been shed. (Psalms 79:10)**
- **Be glad over her, O heaven, also YOU holy ones and YOU apostles and YOU prophets, because God has judicially exacted punishment for YOU from her! (Revelation 18:20)**
- **Yes, in her was found the blood of prophets and of holy ones and of all those who have been slaughtered on the earth. (Revelation 18:24)**
- **And, besides that, YOUR blood of YOUR souls shall I ask back. From the hand of every living creature shall I ask it back, and from the hand of man, from the hand of each one who is his brother, shall I ask back the soul of man. (Genesis 9:5)**
- **Against you, you alone, I have sinned, and what is bad in your eyes I have done, in order that you may prove to be righteous**

- when you speak, that you may be in the clear when you judge. **(Psalms 51:4)**
- And the **righteous** ones will see it and will be afraid, and over him they will laugh. **(Psalms 52:6)**
 - Before Yehowah, for he **has** come to judge the **earth**. He will judge the productive land with righteousness and the peoples with uprightness. **(Psalms 98:9)**
 - About loving-kindness and **judgment** I will sing. To you, O Yehowah, I will make melody. **(Psalms 101:1)**
 - You are **righteous**, O Yehowah, and your judicial decisions are upright. **(Psalms 119:137)**
 - Seven times in the day I have praised you because of your **righteous** judicial decisions. **(Psalms 119:164)**
 - And Yehowah of armies will become high through **judgment**, and the **true** God, the Holy One, will certainly sanctify himself through righteousness. **(Isaiah 5:16)**
 - From the extremity of the land there are melodies that we have heard; Decoration to the Righteous One! But I say; For me there is leanness, for me there is leanness! Woe to me! The treacherous dealers have dealt treacherously. Even with treachery the treacherous dealers have dealt treacherously. **(Isaiah 24:16)**
 - Babylon **has** been a golden cup in the hand of Yehowah, she making all the **earth** drunk. From her wine the nations have drunk. That is why the nations keep acting crazed. **(Jeremiah 51:7)**
 - And over Babylon the heavens and the **earth** and all that is in them will certainly cry out joyfully, for out of the north there will come to her the despoilers, is the utterance of Yehowah. **(Jeremiah 51:48)**
