- **And Yehowah proceeded to answer me and to say; Write down the vision, and set it out plainly upon tablets, in order that the one reading aloud from it may do so fluently. (Habakkuk 2:2)**
- **John to the seven congregations that are in the district of Asia; May you have undeserved kindness and peace from, The One who is and who was and who is coming, and from the seven spirits that are before his throne. (Revelation 1:4)**
- **Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus through God's will, to the holy ones who are in Ephesus and faithful ones in union with Christ Jesus. (Ephesians 1:1)**
- **To the angel of the congregation in Ephesus write; These are the things that he says who holds the seven stars in his right hand, he who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands. (Revelation 2:1)**
- **And to the angel of the congregation in Smyrna write. These are the things that he says; the First and the Last, who became dead and came to life again. (Revelation 2:8)**
- **And to the angel of the congregation in Pergamum write. These are the things that he says who has the sharp, long two-edged sword. (Revelation 2:12)**
- **And to the angel of the congregation in Thyatira write. These are the things that the Son of God says, he who has his eyes like a fiery flame, and his feet are like fine copper. (Revelation 2:18)**
- **And to the angel of the congregation in Sardis write. These are the things that he says who has the seven spirits of God and the seven stars, I know your deeds, that you have the name that you are alive, but you are dead. (Revelation 3:1)**
- **And to the angel of the congregation in Philadelphia write. These are the things he says who is holy, who is true, who has the key**

- of David, who opens so that no one will shut, and shuts so that no one opens. (**Revelation 3:7**)
- **And when this letter has been read among YOU, arrange that it also be read in the congregation of the Laodiceans and that YOU also read the one from Laodicea. (**Colossians 4:16**)**
 - **And to the angel of the congregation in Laodicea write. These are the things that the Amen says, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation by God. (**Revelation 3:14**)**
 - **In the first year of Belshazzar the king of Babylon, Daniel himself beheld a dream and visions of his head upon his bed. At that time he wrote down the dream itself. The complete account of the matters he told. (**Daniel 7:1**)**
 - **And on the Sabbath day we went forth outside the gate beside a river, where we were thinking there was a place of prayer, and we sat down and began speaking to the women that had assembled. (**Acts of Apostles 16:13**)**
 - **Let the one who has an ear hear what the spirit says to the congregations. (**Revelation 3:22**)**
