Revelation 1:11" Saying; What you see write in a scroll and send it to the seven congregations, in Ephesus and in Smyrna and in Pergamum and in Thyatira and in Sardis and in Philadelphia and in Laodicea.

- John to the seven congregations that are in the district of Asia; May you have undeserved kindness and peace from, The One who is and who was and who is coming, and from the seven spirits that are before his throne. (Revelation 1:4)
- Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus through God's will, to the holy ones who are in Ephesus and faithful ones in union with Christ Jesus. (Ephesians 1:1)
- To the angel of the congregation in Ephesus write; These are the things that he says who holds the seven stars in his right hand, he who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands. (Revelation 2:1)
- And to the angel of the congregation in Smyrna write. These are the things that he says; the First and the Last, who became dead and came to life again. (Revelation 2:8)
- And to the angel of the congregation in Pergamum write. These are the things that he says who has the sharp, long two-edged sword. (Revelation 2:12)
- And to the angel of the congregation in Thyatira write. These are the things that the Son of God says, he who has his eyes like a fiery flame, and his feet are like fine copper. (Revelation 2:18)
- And to the angel of the congregation in Sardis write. These are the things that he says who has the seven spirits of God and the seven stars, I know your deeds, that you have the name that you are alive, but you are dead. (Revelation 3:1)
- And to the angel of the congregation in Philadelphia write. These are the things he says who is holy, who is true, who has the key

- of David, who opens so that no one will shut, and shuts so that no one opens. (Revelation 3:7)
- And when this letter has been read among YOU, arrange that it also be read in the congregation of the Laodiceans and that YOU also read the one from Laodicea. (Colossians 4:16)
- And to the angel of the congregation in Laodicea write. These are the things that the Amen says, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation by God. (Revelation 3:14)
- In the first year of Belshazzar the king of Babylon, Daniel himself beheld a dream and visions of his head upon his bed. At that time he wrote down the dream itself. The complete account of the matters he told. (Daniel 7:1)
- And on the Sabbath day we went forth outside the gate beside a river, where we were thinking there was a place of prayer, and we sat down and began speaking to the women that had assembled. (Acts of Apostles 16:13)
- Let the one who has an ear hear what the spirit says to the congregations. (Revelation 3:22)
