- In the year that King Uzziah died I, however, got to see Yehowah, sitting on a throne lofty and lifted up, and his skirts were filling the temple. (**Isaiah 6:1**)
- Seraphs were standing above him. Each one had six wings. With two he kept his face covered, and with two he kept his **feet** covered, and with two he would fly about. (**Isaiah 6:2**)
- And this one called to that one and **said**; Holy, holy, holy is Yehowah of armies. The fullness of all the earth is his glory. (**Isaiah 6:3**)
- And the pivots of the thresholds began to quiver at the voice of the one calling, and the house itself gradually filled with smoke. (**Isaiah 6:4**)
- And I proceeded to say; Woe to me! For I **am** as good as brought to silence, because a man unclean in lips I **am**, and in among a people unclean in lips I **am** dwelling, for my eyes have seen the King, Yehowah of armies, himself! (**Isaiah 6:5**)
- At that, one of the seraphs flew to me, and in his **hand** there was a glowing coal that he had taken with tongs off the altar. (**Isaiah 6:6**)
- And he proceeded to touch my mouth and to say; Look! This has touched your lips, and your error has departed and your sin itself is atoned for. (**Isaiah 6:7**)
- And I began to hear the voice of Yehowah saying; Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? And I proceeded to say; Here I **am**! Send me. (**Isaiah 6:8**)
- And he went on to say; Go, and you must say to this people; Hear again and again, O men, but do not understand, and see again and again, but do not get any knowledge. (**Isaiah 6:9**)

- **Make the heart of this people unreceptive, and make their very ears unresponsive, and paste their very eyes together, that they may not see with their eyes and with their ears they may not hear, and that their own heart may not understand and that they may not actually turn back and get healing for themselves. (Isaiah 6:10)**
- **Then Jesus came near and, touching them, **said**; Get up and have no fear. (Matthew 17:7)**
- **That the Christ was to suffer and, as the first to be resurrected from the **dead**, he was going to publish light both to this people and to the nations. (Acts of Apostles 26:23)**
- **And he is the head of the body, the congregation. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the **dead**, that he might become the one who is first in all things. (Colossians 1:18)**
- **And from Jesus Christ, the Faithful Witness, The Firstborn from the dead, and, The Ruler of the kings of the earth. To him that loves us and that loosed us from our sins by means of his own blood. (Revelation 1:5)**
- **For just as the Father raises the **dead** up and makes them alive, so the Son also makes those alive whom he wants to. (John 5:21)**
- **For this is the will of my Father, that everyone that beholds the Son and exercises faith in him should have everlasting life, and I will resurrect him at the last day. (John 6:40)**
- **And to the angel of the congregation in Smyrna write; These are the things that he says; the **First** and the Last, who became **dead** and came to life again. (Revelation 2:8)**
- **However, Israel put out his **right hand** and placed it on Ephraim's head, although he was the younger, and his left **hand** upon Manasseh's head. He purposely **laid** his **hands** so, since Manasseh was the firstborn. (Genesis 48:14)**
- **There was something like the appearance of the bow that occurs in a cloud mass on the day of a pouring rain. That is how the appearance was of the brightness round about. It was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of Yehowah. When I got to see it, then I **fell** upon my face, and I began to hear the voice of one speaking. (Ezekiel 1:28)**

- **And, look! There was a **hand** that touched me, and it gradually stirred me up to get upon my knees and the palms of my **hands**. (Daniel 10:10)**
- **And he went on to say to me; **Do** not be afraid, O Daniel, for from the first day that you gave your heart to understanding and humbling yourself before your God your words have been heard, and I myself have come because of your words. (Daniel 10:12)**
- **Then he **said**; **Do** not be afraid, O very desirable man. May you have peace. Be strong, yes, be strong. And as soon as he spoke with me I exerted my strength and finally **said**; Let my lord speak, because you have strengthened me. (Daniel 10:19)**
- **But Zechariah became troubled at the sight, and fear **fell** upon him. (Luke 1:12)**
- **Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today, and forever. (Hebrews 13:8)**
