- Then people will deliver **you** up to **tribulation** and will kill **you**, and **you** will be objects of hatred by all the nations on account of my name. (**Matthew 24:9**)
- Sometimes while **you** were being exposed as in a theater both to reproaches and **tribulations**, and sometimes while **you** became **sharers** with those who were having such an experience. (**Hebrews 10:33**)
- Do not be afraid of the things you are **about** to suffer. Look! The Devil will keep on throwing some of **you** into prison that **you** may be fully put to the test, and that **you** may have **tribulation** ten days. Prove yourself faithful even to death, and I will give you the crown of life. (**Revelation 2:10**)
- Have no fear, little flock, because **YOUR** Father has approved of giving **you** the **kingdom**. (**Luke 12:32**)
- And **you** will be objects of hatred by all people on account of my name, but he that has endured to the end is the one that will be saved. (**Matthew 10:22**)
- If we go on enduring, we shall also rule together as kings, if we deny, he also will deny us. (**2 Timothy 2:12**)
- If, then, we are children, we are also heirs. Heirs indeed of **God**, but joint heirs with Christ, provided we suffer together that we may also be glorified together. (**Romans 8:17**)
- But **you** will receive power when the Holy Spirit arrives upon **you**, and **you** will be witnesses of me both in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the most distant part of the earth. (**Acts of Apostles 1:8**)

- He said to them; **You** will indeed drink my cup, but this sitting down at my right hand and at my left is not mine to give, but it belongs to those for whom it has been prepared by my Father. **(Matthew 20:23)**
- They said to him; We are able. At that **Jesus** said to them; The cup I am drinking **you** will drink, and with the baptism with which I am being baptized **you** will be baptized. **(Mark 10:39)**
- In consequence, this saying went out among the **brothers**, that that disciple would not die. However, **Jesus** did not say to him that he would not die, but; If it is my will for him to remain until I come, of what concern is that to you? **(John 21:23)**
- Who bore **witness** to the word **God** gave and to the **witness Jesus** Christ gave, even to all the things he saw. **(Revelation 1:2)**
- And they conquered him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their witnessing, and they did not love their souls even in the face of death. **(Revelation 12:11)**
- And the dragon grew wrathful at the woman, and went off to wage war with the remaining ones of her seed, who observe the commandments of **God** and have the work of **bearing witness to Jesus**. **(Revelation 12:17)**
