

Revelation 20:6 Happy and holy is anyone having part in the first resurrection, over these the second death has no authority, but they will be priests of God and of the Christ, and will rule as kings with him for the thousand years.

- And I heard a voice out of heaven say; Write; Happy are the dead who die in union with the Lord from this time onward. Yes, says the spirit, let them rest from their labors, for the things they did go right with them. (**Revelation 14:13**)
- And, look! I am coming quickly. Happy is **anyone** observing the words of the prophecy of this scroll. (**Revelation 22:7**)
- If **anyone** is meant for captivity, he goes away into captivity. If **anyone will** kill with the sword, he must be killed with the sword. Here is where it means the endurance and faith of the **holy** ones. (**Revelation 13:10**)
- And do not become fearful of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul, but rather be in fear of him that can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna. (**Matthew 10:28**)
- Let the one who **has** an ear hear what the spirit says to the congregations. He that conquers **will** by no means be harmed by the **second** death. (**Revelation 2:11**)
- And **death** and Hades were hurled into the lake of fire. This means the **second death**, the lake of fire. (**Revelation 20:14**)
- But when this which is corruptible puts on incorruption and this which is mortal puts on immortality, then the saying **will** take place that is written: Death is swallowed up forever. (**1 Corinthians 15:54**)
- But **you** are, a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a **holy** nation, a people for special possession, that **you** should declare abroad the excellencies, of the one that called **you** out of darkness into his wonderful light. (**1 Peter 2:9**)
- And he made us to be a kingdom, **priests** to his **God** and Father, yes, to him be the glory and the might forever. Amen. (**Revelation 1:6**)

- And you made them to be a kingdom and **priests** to our **God**, and they are to **rule** as **kings** over the earth. (**Revelation 5:10**)
- I, I myself am the One that is comforting **you** people. Who are you that you should be afraid of a mortal man that **will** die, and of a son of mankind that **will** be rendered as mere green grass? (**Isaiah 51:12**)
- This is what your Lord, Yehowah, even your **God**, who contends for his people, **has** said; Look! I **will** take away from your hand the cup causing reeling. The goblet, my cup of rage, you **will** not repeat the drinking of it anymore. (**Isaiah 51:22**)
- And as for **you**, the **priests** of Yehowah **you will** be called, the ministers of our **God you will** be said to be. The resources of the nations **you** people **will** eat, and in their glory **you will** speak elatedly about yourselves. (**Isaiah 61:6**)
- For I, Yehowah, am loving justice, hating robbery along with unrighteousness. And I **will** give their wages in trueness, and an indefinitely lasting covenant I shall conclude toward them. (**Isaiah 61:8**)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah **has** said to these bones; Here I am bringing into **you** breath, and **you** must come to life. (**Ezekiel 37:5**)
- And the word of Yehowah continued to occur to me, saying; (**Ezekiel 38:1**)
- And in the days of those **kings** the **God** of heaven **will** set up a kingdom that **will** never be brought to ruin. And the kingdom itself **will** not be passed on to any other people. It **will** crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, and it itself **will** stand to times indefinite. (**Daniel 2:44**)
- That **you** may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom, and sit on thrones to judge the twelve tribes of Israel. (**Luke 22:30**)
- Most truly I say to **you**, if **anyone** observes my word, he **will** never see **death** at all. (**John 8:51**)
- But certain ones of both the Epicurean and the Stoic philosophers took to conversing with him controversially, and some would say; What is it this chatterer would like to tell? Others; He seems to be a publisher of foreign deities. This was because he was

- declaring the Good News of Jesus and the **resurrection**. (**Acts of Apostles 17:18**)
- Everlasting life to those who are seeking glory and honor and incorruptibleness by endurance in work that is good. (**Romans 2:7**)
 - Not only that, but we ourselves also who have the firstfruits, namely, the spirit, yes, we ourselves groan within ourselves, while we are earnestly waiting for adoption as sons, the release from our bodies by ransom. (**Romans 8:23**)
 - **You** men already have **YOUR** fill, do **YOU**? **You** are rich already, are **you**? **You** have begun ruling as **kings** without us, have **you**? And I wish indeed that **you** had begun ruling as **kings**, that we also might **rule** with **you** as **kings**. (**1 Corinthians 4:8**)
 - For an administration at the full limit of the appointed times, namely, to gather all things together again in the **Christ**, the things in the heavens and the things on the earth. Yes, in him. (**Ephesians 1:10**)
 - To see if I may by any means attain to the earlier **resurrection** from the dead. (**Philippians 3:11**)
 - Afterward we the living who are surviving **will**, together with them, be caught away in clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and thus we shall always be with the Lord. (**1 Thessalonians 4:17**)
 - As **God** foresaw something better for us, in order that they might not be made perfect apart from us. (**Hebrews 11:40**)
 - In general assembly, and the congregation of the firstborn who have been enrolled in the heavens, and **God** the Judge of all, and the spiritual lives of righteous ones who have been made perfect. (**Hebrews 12:23**)
 - Blessed be the **God** and Father of our Lord Jesus **Christ**, for according to his great mercy he gave us a new birth to a living hope through the **resurrection** of Jesus **Christ** from the dead. (**1 Peter 1:3**)
 - Through these things he **has** freely given us the precious and very grand promises, that through these **you** may become sharers in divine nature, having escaped from the corruption that is in the world through lust. (**2 Peter 1:4**)

- **And she gave birth to a son, a male, who is to shepherd all the nations with an iron rod. And her child was caught away to God and to his throne. (Revelation 12:5)**
- **But as for the cowards and those without faith and those who are disgusting in their filth and murderers and fornicators and those practicing spiritism and idolaters and all the liars, their portion will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulphur. This means the second death. (Revelation 21:8)**
