

**Revelation 21:4** And he will wipe out every tear from their eyes, and death will be no more, neither will mourning nor outcry nor pain be anymore. The former things have passed away.

- And I will be joyful in Jerusalem and exult in my people, and no more will there be heard in her the sound of weeping or the sound of a plaintive cry. (**Isaiah 65:19**)
- Because the Lamb, who is in the midst of the throne, will shepherd them, and will guide them to fountains of waters of life. And God will wipe out every tear from their eyes. (**Revelation 7:17**)
- He will actually swallow up death forever, and the Sovereign Lord Yehowah will certainly wipe the tears from all faces. And the reproach of his people he will take away from all the earth, for Yehowah himself has spoken it. (**Isaiah 25:8**)
- As the last enemy, death is to be brought to nothing. (**1 Corinthians 15:26**)
- And the very ones redeemed by Yehowah will return and certainly come to Zion with a joyful cry, and rejoicing to time indefinite will be upon their head. To exultation and rejoicing they will attain, and grief and sighing must flee away. (**Isaiah 35:10**)
- And I will be joyful in Jerusalem and exult in my people, and no more will there be heard in her the sound of weeping or the sound of a plaintive cry. (**Isaiah 65:19**)
- But by the same word the heavens and the earth that are now are stored up for fire and are being reserved to the day of judgment and of destruction of the ungodly men. (**2 Peter 3:7**)
- So Joseph called the name of the firstborn Manasseh, because, to quote him, God has made me forget all my trouble and all the house of my father. (**Genesis 41:51**)
- Him who is forgiving all your error, who is healing all your maladies. (**Psalms 103:3**)

- And no resident **will** say; I am sick. The people that are dwelling in the land **will** be those pardoned for their error. (**Isaiah 33:24**)
- No more **will** your sun set, nor **will** your moon go on the wane, for Yehowah himself **will** become for you an indefinitely lasting light, and the days of your **mourning will have** come to completion. (**Isaiah 60:20**)
- For here I am creating new heavens and a new earth, and the **former things will** not be called to mind, neither **will** they come up into the heart. (**Isaiah 65:17**)
- They **will** not build and someone else **have** occupancy, they **will** not plant and someone else do the eating. For like the days of a tree **will** the days of my people be, and the work of their own hands my chosen ones **will** use to the full. (**Isaiah 65:22**)
- Happy are **you** who hunger now, because **you will** be filled. Happy are **you** who weep now, because **you will** laugh. (**Luke 6:21**)
- In fact, neither can they die **anymore**, for they are like the angels, and they are God's children by being children of the resurrection. (**Luke 20:36**)
- But when this which is corruptible puts on incorruption and this which is mortal puts on immortality, then the saying **will** take place that is written: Death is swallowed up forever. (**1 Corinthians 15:54**)
