- **The saying of the true proverb has happened to them; The dog has returned to its own vomit, and the sow that was bathed to rolling in the mire. (2 Peter 2:22)**
- **Just like a dog returning to its vomit, the stupid one is repeating his foolishness. (Proverbs 26:11)**
- **Draw close to God, and he will draw close to YOU. Cleanse YOUR hands, YOU sinners, and purify YOUR hearts, YOU indecisive ones. (James 4:8)**
- **You must not bring the hire of a harlot or the price of a dog into the house of Yehowah your God for any vow, because they are something detestable to Yehowah your God, even both of them. (Deuteronomy 23:18)**
- **Do not give what is holy to dogs, neither throw YOUR pearls before swine, that they may never trample them under their feet and turn around and rip YOU open. (Matthew 7:6)**
- **Look out for the dogs, look out for the workers of injury, look out for those who mutilate the flesh. (Philippians 3:2)**
- **Idolatry, practice of spiritism, enmities, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, contentions, divisions, sects. (Galatians 5:20)**
- **For YOU know this, recognizing it for yourselves, that no fornicator or unclean person or greedy person, which means being an idolater, has any inheritance in the kingdom of the Christ and of God. (Ephesians 5:5)**
- **Do not be lying to one another. Strip off the old personality with its practices. (Colossians 3:9)**
- **But as for the cowards and those without faith and those who are disgusting in their filth and murderers and fornicators and those practicing spiritism and idolaters and all the liars, their portion**

- will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulphur. This means the second death. (**Revelation 21:8**)
- You must not preserve a sorceress alive. (**Exodus 22:18**)
  - You will destroy those speaking a lie. A man of bloodshed and deception Yehowah detests. (**Psalms 5:6**)
  - For **dogs** have surrounded me, the assembly of evildoers themselves have enclosed me. Like a lion they are at my hands and my feet. (**Psalms 22:16**)
  - None of those having relations with her will come back, nor will they regain the paths of those living. (**Proverbs 2:19**)
  - It is a rejoicing for the righteous one to do justice, but there is something terrible for those practicing what is hurtful. (**Proverbs 21:15**)
  - And as for the prophet, in case he gets fooled and actually speaks a word, I myself, Yehowah, have fooled that prophet, and I will stretch out my hand against him and annihilate him from the midst of my people Israel. (**Ezekiel 14:9**)
  - And the guard chambers of the gate toward the east were three on this side and three on that side. The three of them were of the same measurement, and the side pillars were of the same measurement, on this side and on that side. (**Ezekiel 40:10**)
  - And it and its porch had windows all around, like these windows. Fifty cubits was the length, and the breadth was twenty-five cubits. (**Ezekiel 40:25**)
  - And I will cut off sorceries out of your hand, and no practicers of magic will you continue to have. (**Micah 5:12**)
  - What! Do **you** not know that unrighteous persons will not inherit God's kingdom? Do not be misled! Neither **fornicators**, nor **idolaters**, nor adulterers, nor men kept for unnatural purposes, nor men who lie with men. (**1 Corinthians 6:9**)
  - And with every unrighteous deception for those who are perishing, as a retribution because they did not accept the love of the truth that they might be saved. (**2 Thessalonians 2:10**)

- **Everyone who hates his brother is a manslayer, and **you** know that no manslayer has everlasting life remaining in him. (1 John 3:15)**
- **Let the one who has an ear hear what the spirit says to the congregations. (Revelation 3:13)**
- **And the winepress was trodden outside the city, and blood came out of the winepress as high up as the bridles of the horses, for a distance of a thousand six hundred furlongs. (Revelation 14:20)**
