Revelation 22:19" And if anyone takes anything away from the words of the scroll of this prophecy, God will take his portion away from the trees of life and out of the holy city, things that are written about in this scroll.

- There are six things that Yehowah does hate, yes, seven are things detestable to his soul. (Proverbs 6:16)
- Lofty eyes, a false tongue, and hands that are shedding innocent blood. (Proverbs 6:17)
- A heart fabricating hurtful schemes, feet that are in a hurry to run to badness. (Proverbs 6:18)
- A false witness that launches forth lies, and anyone sending forth contentions among brothers. (Proverbs 6:19)
- Let the one who has an ear hear what the spirit says to the congregations. To him that conquers I will grant to eat of the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God. (Revelation 2:7)
- Down the middle of its broad way. And on this side of the river and on that side there were trees of life producing twelve crops of fruit, yielding their fruits each month. And the leaves of the trees were for the curing of the nations. (Revelation 22:2)
- I saw also the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God and prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. (Revelation 21:2)
- Let them be wiped out of the book of the living ones, and with the righteous ones may they not be written in. (Psalms 69:28)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Stand in the courtyard of the house of Yehowah, and you must speak concerning all the cities of Judah that are coming in to bow down at the house of Yehowah all the words that I will command you to speak to them. Do not take away a word. (Jeremiah 26:2)
