- In fact, unless those **days** were cut short, no flesh would be saved, but on account of the chosen ones those **days will** be cut short. (**Matthew 24:22**)
- One Lord, one faith, one baptism. (**Ephesians 4:5**)
- Until we all attain to the oneness in the faith and in the accurate knowledge of the Son of God, to a full-grown man, to the measure of stature that belongs to the fullness of the Christ. (**Ephesians 4:13**)
- But the nations became wrathful, and your own wrath came, and the appointed time for the dead to be judged, and to **give** their reward to your slaves the prophets and to the holy ones and to those fearing your name, the small and the great, and to bring to ruin those ruining the earth. (**Revelation 11:18**)
- For the Holy Spirit and we ourselves **have** favored adding no further burden to **you**, except these necessary **things**. (**Acts of Apostles 15:28**)
- To **keep** abstaining from **things** sacrificed to idols and from blood and from **things** strangled and from fornication. If **you** carefully **keep** yourselves from these **things**, **you will** prosper. Good health to **you!** (**Acts of Apostles 15:29**)
- According to the undeserved kindness of God that was given to me, as a wise director of works I laid a foundation, but someone else is building on it. But let each one **keep** watching how he is building on it. (**1 Corinthians 3:10**)
- For no man can lay any other foundation than what is laid, which is Jesus Christ. (**1 Corinthians 3:11**)

- Now if anyone builds on the foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood materials, hay, stubble. (1 Corinthians 3:12)
- Each one's work **will** become manifest, for the day **will** show it up, because it **will** be revealed by means of fire, and the fire itself **will** prove what sort of work each one's is. (1 Corinthians 3:13)
- Every moving animal that is alive may serve as food for **you**. As in the case of green vegetation, I do **give** it all to **you**. (Genesis 9:3)
- Only flesh with its soul, its blood, **you** must not eat. (Genesis 9:4)
- And, besides that, **your** blood of **your** souls shall I ask back. From the hand of every living creature shall I ask it back, and from the hand of man, from the hand of each one who is his brother, shall I ask back the soul of man. (Genesis 9:5)
- Anyone shedding man's blood, by man **will** his own blood be shed, for in God's image he made man. (Genesis 9:6)
- Happy are those who **have** been persecuted for righteousness' sake, since the kingdom of the heavens belongs to them. (Matthew 5:10)
- Happy are **you** when people reproach **you** and persecute **you** and lyingly say every sort of wicked thing against **you** for my sake. (Matthew 5:11)
- Bear in mind the word I said to **you**, a slave is not greater than his master. If they **have** persecuted me, they **will** persecute **you** also, if they **have** observed my word, they **will** observe **yours** also. (John 15:20)
- Keep **your** senses, be watchful. **Your** adversary, the **Devil**, walks **about** like a roaring lion, seeking to devour someone. (1 Peter 5:8)
- And do not become fearful of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul, but rather be in fear of him that can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna. (Matthew 10:28)
- That during a great **test** under affliction their abundance of joy and their deep poverty made the riches of their generosity abound. (2 Corinthians 8:2)

- For in that he himself has suffered when being **put** to the **test**, he is able to come to the aid of those who are being **put** to the **test**. (**Hebrews 2:18**)
- Who **will** separate us from the love of the Christ? Will **tribulation** or distress or persecution or hunger or nakedness or danger or sword? (**Romans 8:35**)
- Sometimes while **you** were being exposed as in a theater both to reproaches and **tribulations**, and sometimes while **you** became sharers with those who were having such an experience. (**Hebrews 10:33**)
- I **have** fought the fine fight, I **have** run the course to the finish, I **have** observed the faith. (**2 Timothy 4:7**)
- Everlasting **life** to those who are seeking glory and honor and incorruptibleness by endurance in work that is good. (**Romans 2:7**)
- Happy is the man that **keeps** on enduring trial, because on becoming approved he **will** receive the **crown of life**, which Yehowah promised to those who continue loving him. (**James 1:12**)
- And I saw thrones, and there were those who sat down on them, and power of judging was given them. Yes, I saw the souls of those executed with the ax for the witness they bore to Jesus and for speaking **about** God, and those who had worshiped neither the wild beast nor its image and who had not received the mark upon their forehead and upon their hand. And they came to **life** and ruled as kings with the Christ for a thousand years. (**Revelation 20:4**)
- It is unthinkable on my part that I should declare **you** men righteous! Until I expire I shall not take away my integrity from myself! (**Job 27:5**)
- The one firmly standing for righteousness is in line for **life**, but the one chasing after what is bad is in line for his own **death**. (**Proverbs 11:19**)
- A name is better than good oil, and the day of **death** than the day of one's being born. (**Ecclesiastes 7:1**)

- And as regards those having insight among the people, they **will** impart understanding to the many. And they **will** certainly be made to stumble by sword and by flame, by captivity and by plundering, for some **days**. (**Daniel 11:33**)
- And some of those having insight **will** be made to stumble, in order to do a refining work because of them and to do a cleansing and to do a whitening, until the time of the end, because it is yet for the time appointed. (**Daniel 11:35**)
- And **you will** be objects of hatred by all people on account of my name, but he that has endured to the end is the one that **will** be saved. (**Matthew 10:22**)
- Then people **will** deliver **you** up to **tribulation** and **will** kill **you**, and **you will** be objects of hatred by all the nations on account of my name. (**Matthew 24:9**)
- But he that has endured to the end is the one that **will** be saved. (**Matthew 24:13**)
- As for **you**, look out for yourselves, people **will** deliver **you** up to local courts, and **you will** be beaten in synagogues and be **put** on the stand before governors and kings for my sake, for a witness to them. (**Mark 13:9**)
- And **you will** be objects of hatred by all people on account of my name. But he that has endured to the end is the one that **will** be saved. (**Mark 13:13**)
- For whoever wants to save his soul **will** lose it, but whoever loses his soul for my sake is the one that **will** save it. (**Luke 9:24**)
- Who **will** not in any way get many times more in this period of time, and in the coming system of **things** everlasting life. (**Luke 18:30**)
- But before all these **things** people **will** lay their hands upon **you** and persecute **you**, delivering **you** up to the synagogues and **prisons**, **you** being haled before kings and governors for the sake of my name. (**Luke 21:12**)
- Jesus said to him; I am the way and the truth and the **life**. No one comes to the Father except through me. (**John 14:6**)

- For if we **have** become united with him in the likeness of his **death**, we shall certainly also be united with him in the likeness of his resurrection. (**Romans 6:5**)
- We are persecuted, but not left in the lurch, we are thrown down, but not destroyed. (**2 Corinthians 4:9**)
- By beatings, by **prisons**, by disorders, by labors, by sleepless nights, by times without food. (**2 Corinthians 6:5**)
- So let us not **give** up in doing what is fine, for in due season we shall reap if we do not tire out. (**Galatians 6:9**)
- Provided, of course, that **you** continue in the faith, established on the foundation and steadfast and not being shifted away from the hope of that Good News which **you** heard, and which was preached in all creation that is under heaven. Of this Good News I Paul became a minister. (**Colossians 1:23**)
- And that we may be delivered from harmful and wicked men, for faith is not a possession of all people. (**2 Thessalonians 3:2**)
- From this time on there is reserved for me the **crown** of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, **will give** me as a reward in that day, yet not only to me, but also to all those who **have** loved his manifestation. (**2 Timothy 4:8**)
- For we actually become partakers of the Christ only if we make fast our hold on the confidence we had at the beginning firm to the end. (**Hebrews 3:14**)
- I John, **your** brother and a sharer with **you** in the **tribulation** and kingdom and endurance in company with Jesus, came to be in the isle that is called Patmos for speaking **about** God and bearing witness to Jesus. (**Revelation 1:9**)
- Let the one who has an ear hear what the spirit says to the congregations; To him that conquers I **will** grant to eat of the tree of **life**, which is in the paradise of God. (**Revelation 2:7**)
- I am coming quickly. Keep on holding fast what you **have**, that no one may take your **crown**. (**Revelation 3:11**)
- If anyone is meant for captivity, he goes away into captivity. If anyone **will** kill with the sword, he must be killed with the sword.
