

Revelation 2:16 **Therefore repent. If you do not, I am coming to you quickly, and I will war with them with the long sword of my mouth.**

[9] - References:

- And out of his **mouth** there protrudes a sharp long **sword**, that he may strike the nations with it, and he **will** shepherd them with a rod of iron. He treads too the winepress of the anger of the wrath of God the Almighty. (**Revelation 19:15**)
- For the word of God is alive and exerts power and is sharper than any two-edged **sword** and pierces even to the dividing of soul and spirit, and of joints and their marrow, and is able to discern thoughts and intentions of the heart. (**Hebrews 4:12**)
- Repent, therefore, and turn around so as to get **YOUR** sins blotted out, that seasons of refreshing may come from the person of Yehowah (**Acts of Apostles 3:19**)
- And with righteousness he must judge the lowly ones, and with uprightness he must give reproof in behalf of the meek ones of the earth. And he must strike the earth with the rod of his **mouth**, and with the spirit of his lips he **will** put the wicked one to death. (**Isaiah 11:4**)
- And he had in his right hand seven stars, and out of his **mouth** a sharp, long two-edged **sword** was protruding, and his countenance was as the sun when it shines in its power. (**Revelation 1:16**)
- A third you **will** burn in the very fire in the midst of the city as soon as the days of the siege have come to the full. And you must take another third. You **will** strike it with the **sword** all around her, and the last third you **will** scatter to the wind, and I shall draw out a **sword** itself after them. (**Ezekiel 5:2**)
- Therefore remember from what you have fallen, and repent and do the former deeds. If you do not, I **am coming** to you, and I **will** remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent. (**Revelation 2:5**)
- I **am coming quickly**. Keep on holding fast what you have, that no one may take your crown. (**Revelation 3:11**)

- **But the rest were killed off with the long sword of the one seated on the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth. And all the birds were filled from the fleshy parts of them. (Revelation 19:21)**
