- **Please, may the badness of wicked ones come to an end, and may you establish the righteous one, and God as righteous is testing out heart and **kidneys**. (Psalms 7:9)**
- **But Yehowah of armies is judging with righteousness, he is examining the **kidneys** and the heart. O may I see your vengeance on them, for it is to you that I have revealed my case at Law. (Jeremiah 11:20)**
- **I, Yehowah, **am** searching the heart, examining the **kidneys**, even to **give** to each one according to his ways, according to the fruitage of his dealings. (Jeremiah 17:10)**
- **And it must occur at that time that I shall carefully search Jerusalem with lamps, and I **will give** attention to the men who are congealing upon their dregs and who are saying in their heart, Yehowah **will** not do good, and he **will** not do bad. (Zephaniah 1:12)**
- **But Jesus, having discerned immediately by his spirit that they were reasoning that way in themselves, said to them; Why are **YOU** reasoning these things in **YOUR hearts**? (Mark 2:8)**
