- But a famine came upon the whole of Egypt and Canaan, even a great tribulation, and our forefathers were not finding any provisions. (**Acts of Apostles 7:11**)
- For **YOU** both expressed sympathy for those in prison and joyfully took the plundering of **YOUR** belongings, knowing **YOU** yourselves have a better and an abiding possession. (**Hebrews 10:34**)
- But one of the elders says to me; Stop weeping. Look! The Lion that is of the tribe of Judah, the root of David, has conquered so as to open the scroll and its seven seals. (**Revelation 5:5**)
- Happy are those who have been persecuted for righteousness' sake, since the kingdom of the heavens belongs to them. (**Matthew 5:10**)
- Happy are **YOU** when people reproach **YOU** and persecute **YOU** and lyingly say every sort of wicked thing against **YOU** for my sake. (**Matthew 5:11**)
- Teaching them to observe all the things I have commanded **YOU**. And, look! I am with **YOU** all the days until the conclusion of the system of things. (**Matthew 28:20**)
- Ask of me, that I may **give nations** as your inheritance and the **ends** of the earth as your own possession. (**Psalms 2:8**)
- Jesus said to them; Truly I say to **YOU**, in the re-creation, when the Son of man sits **down** upon his glorious throne, **YOU** who have followed me **will** also yourselves sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. (**Matthew 19:28**)
- And I make a covenant with **YOU**, just as my Father has made a covenant with me, for a kingdom. (**Luke 22:29**)
- To the one that conquers I **will** grant to sit **down** with me on my throne, even as I conquered and sat **down** with my Father on his throne. (**Revelation 3:21**)

- **And I saw thrones, and there were those who sat **down** on them, and power of judging was given them. Yes, I saw the souls of those executed with the ax for the witness they bore to Jesus and for speaking about God, and those who had worshiped neither the wild beast nor its image and who had not received the mark upon their forehead and upon their hand. And they came to life and ruled as kings with the Christ for a thousand years. (**Revelation 20:4**)**
- **Instruct me, O Yehowah, in the way of your regulations, that I may observe it **down** to the last. (**Psalms 119:33**)**
- **So he said to him; Well done, good slave! Because in a very small matter you have proved yourself faithful, hold **authority** over ten cities. (**Luke 19:17**)**
- **That **you** may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom, and sit on thrones to judge the twelve tribes of Israel. (**Luke 22:30**)**
