Revelation 2:27" And he shall shepherd the people with an iron rod so that they will be broken to pieces like clay vessels, the same, as I have received from my Father.

- And she gave birth to a son, a male, who is to shepherd all the nations with an iron rod. And her child was caught away to God and to his throne. (Revelation 12:5)
- And out of his mouth there protrudes a sharp long sword, that he may strike the nations with it, and he will shepherd them with a rod of iron. He treads too the winepress of the anger of the wrath of God the Almighty. (Revelation 19:15)
- You will break them with an iron scepter, as though a potter's vessel you will dash them to pieces. (Psalms 2:9)
- And in the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that will never be brought to ruin. And the kingdom itself will not be passed on to any other people. It will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, and it itself will stand to times indefinite. (Daniel 2:44)
- Get up and thresh, O daughter of Zion, for your horn I shall change into iron, and your hoofs I shall change into copper, and you will certainly pulverize many peoples, and by a ban you will actually devote to Yehowah their unjust profit, and their resources to the true Lord of the whole earth. (Micah 4:13)
- The rod of your strength Yehowah will send out of Zion, saying; Go subduing in the midst of your enemies. (Psalms 110:2)
- For because of the voice of Yehowah Assyria will be struck with terror, he will strike it even with a staff. (Isaiah 30:31)
- For any nation and any kingdom that will not serve you will perish, and the nations themselves will without fail come to devastation. (Isaiah 60:12)
- And you must say to them; This is what Yehowah of armies has said; In the same way I shall break this people and this city as someone breaks the vessel of the potter so that it is no more able

to be repaired, and in Topheth they will bury until there is no more place to bury. (Jeremiah 19:11)
