

Revelation 3:1 And to the angel of the congregation in Sardis write. These are the things that he says who has the seven spirits of God and the seven stars, I know your deeds, that you have the name that you are alive, but you are dead.

- And **God** went on to say; Let luminaries come to be in the expanse of the heavens to make a division between the day and the night, and they must serve as signs and for seasons and for days and years. (**Genesis 1:14**)
- After that he had still another dream, and he related it to his brothers and said; Here I **have** had a dream once more, and here the sun and the moon and eleven **stars** were bowing down to me. (**Genesis 37:9**)
- Then he related it to his father as well as his brothers, and his father began to rebuke him and say to him; What does this dream that you **have** dreamed mean? Am I and also your mother and your brothers for certain going to come and bow down to the earth to you? (**Genesis 37:10**)
- And his brothers grew jealous of him, but his father observed the saying; (**Genesis 37:11**)
- And the ones having insight will shine like the brightness of the expanse, and those who are bringing the many to righteousness, like the **stars** to time indefinite, even forever. (**Daniel 12:3**)
- But he that **has** endured to the end is the one that will be saved. (**Matthew 24:13**)
- What do **you** think? A man had two children. Going up to the first, he said, Child, go work today in the vineyard. (**Matthew 21:28**)
- In answer this one said, **I** will, sir, but did not go out. (**Matthew 21:29**)
- Approaching the second, he said the same. In reply this one said; **I** will not. Afterwards he felt regret and went out. (**Matthew 21:30**)

- Which of the two did the will of his father? They said; The latter. Jesus said to them; Truly I say to **you** that the tax collectors and the harlots are going ahead of **you** into the kingdom of **God**. (**Matthew 21:31**)
- For John came to **you** in a way of righteousness, but **you** did not believe him. However, the tax collectors and the harlots believed him, and **you**, although **you** saw this, did not feel regret afterwards so as to believe him. (**Matthew 21:32**)
- To the angel of the **congregation** in Ephesus **write**; These are the **things** that he **says** who holds the **seven stars** in his right hand, he who walks in the midst of the **seven** golden lampstands. (**Revelation 2:1**)
- John to the **seven congregations** that are in the district of Asia; May **you have** undeserved kindness and peace from, The One who is and who was and who is coming, and from the **seven spirits** that are before his throne. (**Revelation 1:4**)
- And out of the throne there are proceeding lightnings and voices and thunders, and there are **seven** lamps of fire burning before the throne, and these mean the **seven spirits** of **God**. (**Revelation 4:5**)
- Indeed, as the body without spirit is **dead**, so also faith without works is **dead**. (**James 2:26**)
- And he had in his right hand **seven stars**, and out of his mouth a sharp, long two-edged sword was protruding, and his countenance was as the sun when it shines in its power. (**Revelation 1:16**)
- We keep groping for the wall just like blind men, and like those without eyes we keep groping. We **have** stumbled at high noon just as in evening darkness, among the stout ones we are just like **dead** people. (**Isaiah 59:10**)
- Because this my son was **dead** and came to life again, he was lost and was found. And they started to enjoy themselves. (**Luke 15:24**)
- Saying; What you see **write** in a scroll and send it to the **seven congregations**, in Ephesus and in Smyrna and in Pergamum and in Thyatira and in **Sardis** and in Philadelphia and in Laodicea. (**Revelation 1:11**)

- **I know your deeds, and your labor and endurance, and that you cannot bear bad men, and that you put those to the test who say they are apostles, but they are not, and you found them liars. (Revelation 2:2)**
