- Then two men **will** be in the field, one **will** be taken along and the other be abandoned. (**Matthew 24:40**)
- Two women **will** be grinding at the hand mill, one **will** be taken along and the other be abandoned. (**Matthew 24:41**)
- Keep on the watch, therefore, because **YOU** do not know on what day **YOUR** Lord is coming. (**Matthew 24:42**)
- As for that on the fine soil, these are the ones that, after hearing the **word** with a fine and good heart, retain it and bear fruit with **endurance**. (**Luke 8:15**)
- By **endurance** on **YOUR** part **YOU will** acquire **YOUR** souls. (**Luke 21:19**)
- If we go on enduring, we shall also rule together as kings, if we deny, he also **will** deny us. (**2 Timothy 2:12**)
- For **YOU** have need of **endurance**, in order that, after **YOU** have done the **will** of God, **YOU** may receive the fulfillment of the promise. (**Hebrews 10:36**)
- Indeed, consider closely the one who has endured such contrary talk by sinners against their own interests, that **YOU** may not get tired and give out in **YOUR** souls. (**Hebrews 12:3**)
- But the Lord is faithful, and he **will** make **YOU** firm and **keep you** from the wicked one. (**2 Thessalonians 3:3**)
- Yehowah knows how to deliver people of godly devotion out of trial, but to reserve unrighteous people for the day of judgment to be cut off. (**2 Peter 2:9**)

- For then there **will** be great tribulation such as has not occurred since the world's beginning until now, no, nor **will** occur again. (**Matthew 24:21**)
- As for the one listening to me, he **will** reside in security and be undisturbed from dread of calamity. (**Proverbs 1:33**)
- And do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us from the wicked one. (**Matthew 6:13**)
- And forgive us our sins, for we ourselves also forgive everyone that is in debt to us, and do not bring us into temptation. (**Luke 11:4**)
- For in that he himself has suffered when being **put** to the **test**, he is able to **come** to the aid of those who are being **put** to the **test**. (**Hebrews 2:18**)
