Revelation 3:12. The one that conquers, I will make him a pillar in the temple of my God, and he will by no means go out from it anymore, and I will write upon him the name of my God and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem which descends out of heaven from my God, and that new name of mine.

- You are my witnesses, is the utterance of Yehowah, even my servant whom I have chosen, in order that you may know and have faith in me, and that you may understand that I am the same One. Before me there was no God formed, and after me there continued to be none. (Isaiah 43:10)
- I, I am Yehowah, and besides me there is no savior. (Isaiah 43:11)
- I have made your name manifest to the men you gave me out of the world. They were yours, and you gave them to me, and they have observed your word. (John 17:6)
- And I have made your name known to them and will make it known, in order that the love with which you loved me may be in them and I in union with them. (John 17:26)
- And he proceeded to set up the pillars in front of the temple, one to the right and one to the left, after which he called the name of the right-hand one Jachin and the name of the left-hand one Boaz. (2 Chronicles 3:17)
- Do you not know that you people are God's temple, and that the spirit of God dwells in you? (1 Corinthians 3:16)
- In union with him the whole building, being harmoniously joined together, is growing into a holy temple for Yehowah. (Ephesians 2:21)
- You yourselves also as living stones are being built up a spiritual house for the purpose of a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. (1 Peter 2:5)

- Jesus said to her; Stop clinging to me. For I have not yet ascended to the Father. But be on your way to my brothers and say to them, I am ascending to my Father and your Father and to my God and your God. (John 20:17)
- But You have approached a Mount Zion and a city of the living God, heavenly Jerusalem, and myriads of angels. (Hebrews 12:22)
- I saw also the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God and prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. (Revelation 21:2)
- And I saw, and, look! The Lamb standing upon the Mount Zion, and with him a hundred and forty-four thousand having his name and the name of his Father written on their foreheads. (Revelation 14:1)
- His eyes are a fiery flame, and upon his head are many diadems. He has a name written that no one knows but he himself. (Revelation 19:12)
- And they will see his face, and his name will be on their foreheads. (Revelation 22:4)
- And he proceeded to set up the pillars belonging to the porch of the temple. So he set up the right-hand pillar and called its name Jachin, and then set up the left-hand pillar and called its name Boaz. (1 Kings 7:21)
- Then he made before the house two pillars, thirty-five cubits in length, and the capital that was upon the top of each one was five cubits. (2 Chronicles 3:15)
- This one will say; I belong to Yehowah. And that one will call himself by the name of Jacob, and another will write upon his hand. Belonging to Yehowah. And by the name of Israel one will betitle himself. (Isaiah 44:5)
- Because of the trouble of his soul he will see, he will be satisfied. By means of his knowledge the righteous one, my servant, will bring a righteous standing to many people, and their errors he himself will bear. (Isaiah 53:11)
- Then he made side pillars of sixty cubits, even to the side pillars of the courtyard in the gates all around. (Ezekiel 40:14)

- And the dining room the front of which is toward the north is for the priests who are taking care of the obligation of the altar. They are the sons of Zadok, who, from the sons of Levi, are approaching Yehowah to minister to him. (Ezekiel 40:46)
- And all the way to the Prince of the army it put on great airs, and from him the constant feature was taken away, and the established place of his sanctuary was thrown down. (Daniel 8:11)
- For we do not have here a city that continues, but we are earnestly seeking the one to come. (Hebrews 13:14)
- Let the one who has an ear hear what the spirit says to the congregations; To him that conquers I will give some of the hidden manna, and I will give him a white pebble, and upon the pebble a new name written which no one knows except the one receiving it. (Revelation 2:17)
- Anyone conquering will inherit these things, and I shall be his God and he will be my son. (Revelation 21:7)
- So he carried me away in the power of the spirit to a great and lofty mountain, and he showed me the holy city Jerusalem coming down out of heaven from God (Revelation 21:10)
- And the city lies foursquare, and its length is as great as its breadth. And he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs, its length and breadth and height are equal. (Revelation 21:16)
