Revelation 3:14^{..} And to the angel of the congregation in Laodicea write. These are the things that the Amen¹ says, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation by God.

- And from Jesus Christ, the Faithful Witness, The Firstborn from the dead, and, The Ruler of the kings of the earth. To him that

loves us and that loosed us from our sins by means of his own blood. (Revelation 1:5)

- So the Word became flesh and resided among us, and we had a view of his glory, a glory such as belongs to an only-begotten son from a father, and he was full of undeserved kindness and truth. (John 1:14)
- And I saw the heaven opened, and, look! A white horse. And the one seated upon it is called Faithful and True, and he judges and carries on war in righteousness. (Revelation 19:11)
