

Revelation 3:18 **I advise you to buy from me gold refined by fire that you may become rich, and white outer garments that you may become dressed and that the shame of your nakedness may not become manifested, and eye-salve to rub in your eyes that you may see.**

- **So Israel's sons came along with the others who were coming to buy, because the famine existed in the land of Canaan. (Genesis 42:5)**
- **And it came about that as soon as they had finished eating up the cereals they had brought from Egypt, their father proceeded to say to them; Return, buy a little food for us. (Genesis 43:2)**
- **And the ones having insight will shine like the brightness of the expanse, and those who are bringing the many to righteousness, like the stars to time indefinite, even forever. (Daniel 12:3)**
- **And as for the toes of the feet being partly of iron and partly of molded clay, the kingdom will partly prove to be strong and will partly prove to be fragile. (Daniel 2:42)**
- **Whereas you beheld iron mixed with moist clay, they will come to be mixed with the offspring of mankind, but they will not prove to be sticking together, this one to that one, just as iron is not mixing with molded clay. (Daniel 2:43)**
- **As regards that image, its head was of good gold, its breasts and its arms were of silver, its belly and its thighs were of copper. (Daniel 2:32)**
- **Its legs were of iron, its feet were partly of iron and partly of molded clay. (Daniel 2:33)**
- **You kept on looking until a stone was cut out not by hands, and it struck the image on its feet of iron and of molded clay and crushed them. (Daniel 2:34)**
- **At that time the iron, the molded clay, the copper, the silver and the gold were, all together, crushed and became like the chaff from the summer threshing floor, and the wind carried them away so that no trace at all was found of them. And as for the**

- stone that struck the image, it became a large mountain and filled the whole earth. (**Daniel 2:35**)
- And the greetings in the marketplaces and to be called Rabbi by men. (**Matthew 23:7**)
 - But **YOU**, do not **YOU** be called Rabbi, for one is **YOUR** teacher, whereas all **YOU** are brothers. (**Matthew 23:8**)
 - Moreover, do not call anyone **YOUR** father on earth, for one is **YOUR** Father, the heavenly One. (**Matthew 23:9**)
 - Neither be called leaders, for **YOUR** Leader is one, the Christ. (**Matthew 23:10**)
 - But the greatest one among **YOU** must be **YOUR** minister. (**Matthew 23:11**)
 - Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted. (**Matthew 23:12**)
 - Why have the nations been in tumult and the national groups themselves kept muttering an empty thing? (**Psalms 2:1**)
 - The kings of earth take their stand and high officials themselves have massed together as one against Yehowah and against his anointed one. (**Psalms 2:2**)
 - Saying; Let us tear their bands apart and cast their cords away from us! (**Psalms 2:3**)
 - The very One sitting in the heavens will laugh, Yehowah himself will hold them in derision. (**Psalms 2:4**)
 - At that time he will speak to them in his anger and in his hot displeasure he will disturb them. (**Psalms 2:5**)
 - Saying; I, even I, have installed my king upon Zion, my holy mountain. (**Psalms 2:6**)
 - Let me refer to the decree of Yehowah, he has said to me You are my son, I, today, I have **become** your father. (**Psalms 2:7**)
 - Ask of me, that I may give nations as your inheritance and the ends of the earth as your own possession. (**Psalms 2:8**)

- You will break them with an iron scepter, as though a potter's vessel you will dash them to pieces. (**Psalms 2:9**)
- And now, O kings, exercise insight, let yourselves be corrected, O judges of the earth. (**Psalms 2:10**)
- Serve Yehowah with fear and be joyful with trembling. (**Psalms 2:11**)
- Kiss the son, that He may not **become** incensed and **you** may not perish from the way, for his anger flares up easily. Happy are all those taking refuge in him. (**Psalms 2:12**)
- Wherefore he says; Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and the Christ will shine upon you. (**Ephesians 5:14**)
- For he well knows the way I take. After he has tested me out, I shall come forth as **gold** itself. (**Job 23:10**)
- In order that the tested quality of **YOUR** faith, of much greater value than **gold** that perishes despite its being proved by **fire**, may be found a cause for praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ. (**1 Peter 1:7**)
- Look! I am coming as a thief. Happy is the one that stays awake and keeps his **outer garments**, that he may not walk naked and people look upon his shamefulness. (**Revelation 16:15**)
- The orders from Yehowah are upright, causing the heart to rejoice, the commandment of Yehowah is clean, making the **eyes** shine. (**Psalms 19:8**)
- And Yehowah God proceeded to make long **garments** of skin for Adam and for his wife and to clothe them. (**Genesis 3:21**)
- And they proceeded to go to Ophir and take from there four hundred and twenty talents of **gold** and bring it in to King Solomon. (**1 Kings 9:28**)
- Buy truth itself and do not sell it, wisdom and discipline and understanding. (**Proverbs 23:23**)
- And Egypt will not come to have any work that the head or the tail, the shoot or the rush, can do. (**Isaiah 19:15**)

- **And in that day the deaf ones will certainly hear the words of the book, and out of the gloom and out of the darkness even the eyes of the blind ones will see. (Isaiah 29:18)**
- **Incline YOUR ear and come to me. Listen, and YOUR soul will keep alive, and I shall readily conclude with YOU people an indefinitely lasting covenant respecting the loving-kindnesses to David that are faithful. (Isaiah 55:3)**
- **The kingdom of the heavens is like a treasure hidden in the field, which a man found and hid, and for the joy he has he goes and sells what things he has and buys that field. (Matthew 13:44)**
- **Therefore, if YOU have not proved yourselves faithful in connection with the unrighteous riches, who will entrust YOU with what is true? (Luke 16:11)**
- **So that, having really put it on, we shall not be found naked. (2 Corinthians 5:3)**
- **Nevertheless, you do have a few names in Sardis that did not defile their outer garments, and they shall walk with me in white ones, because they are worthy. (Revelation 3:4)**
