Revelation 3:19. All those for whom I have affection I reprove and discipline. Therefore be zealous and repent.

[14] - References:

- Because the one whom Yehowah loves he reproves, even as a father does a son in whom he finds pleasure. (Proverbs 3:12)
- Therefore remember from what you have fallen, and repent and do the former deeds. If you do not, I am coming to you, and I will remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent. (Revelation 2:5)
- Therefore, continue mindful of how you have received and how you heard, and go on keeping it, and repent. Certainly unless you wake up, I shall come as a thief, and you will not know at all at what hour I shall come upon you. (Revelation 3:3)
- And you well know with your own heart that just as a man corrects his son, Yehowah your God was correcting you. (Deuteronomy 8:5)
- Turn back at my reproof. Then to you I will cause my spirit to bubble forth, I will make my words known to you. (Proverbs 1:23)
- The ridiculer you should strike, that the inexperienced one may become shrewd, and there should be a reproving of the understanding one, that he may discern knowledge. (Proverbs 19:25)
- The wounds inflicted by a lover are faithful, but the kisses of a hater are things to be entreated. (Proverbs 27:6)
- Better is it to hear the rebuke of someone wise than to be the man hearing the song of the stupid ones. (Ecclesiastes 7:5)
- Do not be afraid, for I am with you. Do not gaze about, for I am your God. I will fortify you. I will really help you. I will really keep fast hold of you with my right hand of righteousness. (Isaiah 41:10)
- As for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, is the utterance of Yehowah, for I am with you. For I shall make an extermination among all the nations to which I have dispersed

- you, but with you I shall make no extermination. Yet I shall have to chastise you to the proper degree, and I shall absolutely not leave you unpunished. (Jeremiah 46:28)
- There was a looking for much, but here there was just a little, and you have brought it into the house, and I blew upon it, for what reason? is the utterance of Yehowah of armies. By reason of my house that is waste, while you are on the run, each one in behalf of his own house. (Haggai 1:9)
- And quit sharing with them in the unfruitful works that belong to the darkness, but, rather, even be reproving them. (Ephesians 5:11)
- Reprove before all onlookers persons who practice sin, that the rest also may have fear. (1 Timothy 5:20)
- Holding firmly to the faithful word as respects his art of teaching, that he may be able both to exhort by the teaching that is healthful and to reprove those who contradict. (Titus 1:9)
