

Revelation 3:21 To the one that conquers I will grant to sit down with me on my throne, even as I conquered and sat down with my Father on his throne.

[23] - References:

- Therefore Pilate said to him; Well, then, are you a king? Jesus answered; You yourself are saying that I am a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone that is on the side of the truth listens to my voice. (**John 18:37**)
- And a great sign was seen in heaven, a woman arrayed with the sun, and the moon was beneath her feet, and on her head was a crown of twelve stars. (**Revelation 12:1**)
- And she was pregnant. And she cries out in her pains and in her agony to give birth. (**Revelation 12:2**)
- And another sign was seen in heaven, and, look! A great fiery-colored dragon, with seven heads and ten horns and upon its heads seven diadems. (**Revelation 12:3**)
- Because everything that has been born from God conquers the world. And this is the conquest that has **conquered** the world, our faith. (**1 John 5:4**)
- Faith is the assured expectation of things hoped for, the evident demonstration of realities though not beheld. (**Hebrews 11:1**)
- And to him that conquers and observes my deeds **down** to the end I **will** give authority over the nations. (**Revelation 2:26**)
- And they **conquered** him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their witnessing, and they did not love their souls **even** in the face of death. (**Revelation 12:11**)
- Jesus said to them; Truly I say to **you**, in the re-creation, when the Son of man **sits down** upon his glorious **throne**, **you** who have followed me **will** also yourselves **sit** upon twelve **thrones**, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. (**Matthew 19:28**)
- That **you** may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom, and **sit** on **thrones** to judge the twelve tribes of Israel. (**Luke 22:30**)

- **But this man offered one sacrifice for sins perpetually and **sat down** at the right hand of God. (**Hebrews 10:12**)**
- **This is what Yehowah has said; The heavens are my **throne**, and the earth is my footstool. Where, then, is the house that **you** people can build for me, and where, then, is the place as a resting-place for me? (**Isaiah 66:1**)**
- **And I **will** cause him to stand in my house and in my kingship to time indefinite, and his **throne will** itself become one lasting to time indefinite. (**1 Chronicles 17:14**)**
- **And I **will** drive him in as a peg in a lasting place, and he must become as a **throne** of glory to the house of his father. (**Isaiah 22:23**)**
- **And to him there were given rulership and dignity and kingdom, that the peoples, national groups and languages should all serve **even** him. His rulership is an indefinitely lasting rulership that **will** not pass away, and his kingdom one that **will** not be brought to ruin. (**Daniel 7:14**)**
- **But the holy ones of the Supreme One **will** receive the kingdom, and they **will** take possession of the kingdom for time indefinite, **even** for time indefinite upon times indefinite. (**Daniel 7:18**)**
- **When the Son of man arrives in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he **will sit down** on his glorious **throne**. (**Matthew 25:31**)**
- **If, then, we are children, we are also heirs; heirs indeed of God, but joint heirs with Christ, provided we suffer together that we may also be glorified together. (**Romans 8:17**)**
- **You men already have **your** fill, do **you**? **You** are rich already, are **you**? **You** have begun ruling as kings without us, have **you**? And I wish indeed that **you** had begun ruling as kings, that we also might rule with **you** as kings. (**1 Corinthians 4:8**)**
- **Stripping the governments and the authorities bare, he exhibited them in open public as **conquered**, leading them in a triumphal procession by means of it. (**Colossians 2:15**)**
- **If we go on enduring, we shall also rule together as kings, if we deny, he also **will** deny us. (**2 Timothy 2:12**)**

- **But with reference to the Son: God is your **throne** forever and ever, and the scepter of your kingdom is the scepter of uprightness. (**Hebrews 1:8**)**
- **And round about the **throne** there are twenty-four **thrones**, and upon these **thrones** I saw seated twenty-four elders dressed in white outer garments, and upon their heads golden crowns. (**Revelation 4:4**)**
- **And no more **will** there be any curse. But the **throne** of God and of the Lamb **will** be in the city, and his slaves **will** render him sacred service. (**Revelation 22:3**)**
- **Also, night **will** be no more, and they have no need of lamplight nor do they have sunlight, because Yehowah God **will** shed light upon them, and they **will** rule as kings forever and ever. (**Revelation 22:5**)**
