Revelation 3:3" Therefore, continue mindful of how you have received and how you heard, and go on keeping it, and repent. Certainly unless you wake up, I shall come as a thief, and you will not know at all at what hour I shall come upon you.

- But know this, that if the householder had known at what hour the thief would come, he would have kept watching and not have let his house be broken into. (Luke 12:39)
- That is why justice has come to be far away from us, and righteousness does not catch up with us. We keep hoping for light, but, look! Darkness, for brightness, but in continuous gloom we kept walking. (Isaiah 59:9)
- We keep groping for the wall just like blind men, and like those without eyes we keep groping. We have stumbled at high noon just as in evening darkness, among the stout ones we are just like dead people. (Isaiah 59:10)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Look! My own servants will eat, but you yourselves will go hungry. Look! My own servants will drink, but you yourselves will go thirsty. Look! My own servants will rejoice, but you yourselves will suffer shame. (Isaiah 65:13)
- And he continued saying to me; Son of man, here I am breaking the rods around which ring-shaped loaves are suspended, in Jerusalem, and they will have to eat bread by weight and in anxious care, and it will be by measure and in horror that they will drink water itself. (Ezekiel 4:16)
- When I send the injurious arrows of the famine upon them, which must prove to be for ruination, which arrows I shall send to bring you people to ruin, even famine I shall increase upon you people and I will break your rods around which ring-shaped loaves are suspended. (Ezekiel 5:16)
- And you kept decking yourself with gold and silver, and your attire was fine linen and costly material and an embroidered garment. Fine flour and honey and oil were what you ate, and you grew to be very, very pretty, and gradually you became fit for royal position. (Ezekiel 16:13)

- While the bridegroom was delaying, they all nodded and went to sleep. (Matthew 25:5)
- Right in the middle of the night there arose a cry; Here is the bridegroom! Be on YOUR way out to meet him. (Matthew 25:6)
- Then all those virgins rose and put their lamps in order. (Matthew 25:7)
- Keep on the watch, therefore, because you do not know on what day your Lord is coming. (Matthew 24:42)
- Taste and see that Yehowah is good, O you people, happy is the able-bodied man that takes refuge in him. (Psalms 34:8)
- Cure sick people, raise up dead persons, make lepers clean, expel demons. You received free, give free. (Matthew 10:8)
- Keep awake, then, all the time making supplication that YOU may succeed in escaping all these things that are destined to occur, and in standing before the Son of man. (Luke 21:36)
- Keeping a tight grip on the word of life, that I may have cause for exultation in Christ's day, that I did not run in vain or work hard in vain. (Philippians 2:16)
- So then produce fruit that befits repentance. (Matthew 3:8)
- Therefore, since we have these promises, beloved ones, let us cleanse ourselves of every defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in God's fear. (2 Corinthians 7:1)
- Wherefore he says; Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and the Christ will shine upon you. (Ephesians 5:14)
- Look! I am coming as a thief. Happy is the one that stays awake and keeps his outer garments, that he may not walk naked and people look upon his shamefulness. (Revelation 16:15)
- Keep on the watch, therefore, because you do not know on what day your Lord is coming. (Matthew 24:42)
- But know this, that if the householder had known at what hour the thief would come, he would have kept watching and not have let his house be broken into. (Luke 12:39)

- He that is walking faultless will be saved, but he that is made crooked in his ways will fall at once. (Proverbs 28:18)
- And the crash of revolters and that of sinful ones will be at the same time, and those leaving Yehowah will come to their finish. (Isaiah 1:28)
- Tremble, YOU women who are at ease! Be agitated, YOU careless ones! Undress and make yourselves naked, and gird sackcloth upon the loins. (Isaiah 32:11)
- Why is it that, when I came in, there was no one? When I called, there was nobody answering? Has my hand become in fact so short that it cannot redeem, or is there in me no power to deliver? Look! With my rebuke I dry up the sea, I make rivers a wilderness. Their fish stink due to there being no water, and they die because of thirst. (Isaiah 50:2)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; I will also cause a blast of windstorms to burst forth in my rage, and in my anger there will occur a flooding downpour, and in rage there will be hailstones for an extermination. (Ezekiel 13:13)
- But know one thing, that if the householder had known in what watch the thief was coming, he would have kept awake and not allowed his house to be broken into. (Matthew 24:43)
- Therefore keep on the watch, for you do not know when the master of the house is coming, whether late in the day or at midnight or at cockcrowing or early in the morning. (Mark 13:35)
- You also, keep ready, because at an hour that you do not think likely the Son of man is coming. (Luke 12:40)
- But if we would discern what we ourselves are, we would not be judged. (1 Corinthians 11:31)
- For you yourselves know quite well that Yehowah's day is coming exactly as a thief in the night. (1 Thessalonians 5:2)
- Just the same, hold fast what you have until I come. (Revelation 2:25)
- All those for whom I have affection I reprove and discipline. Therefore be zealous and repent. (Revelation 3:19)
