

**Revelation 3:3** Therefore, continue mindful of how you have received and how you heard, and go on keeping it, and repent. Certainly unless you wake up, I shall come as a thief, and you will not know at all at what hour I shall come upon you.

[30] - References:

- But **know** this, that if the householder had known at **what hour** the **thief** would **come**, he would **have** kept watching and not **have** let his house be broken into. (**Luke 12:39**)
- That is why justice has **come** to be far away from us, and righteousness does not catch up with us. We keep hoping for light, but, look! Darkness, for brightness, but in continuous gloom we kept walking. (**Isaiah 59:9**)
- We keep groping for the wall just like blind men, and like those without eyes we keep groping. We **have** stumbled at high noon just as in evening darkness, among the stout ones we are just like dead people. (**Isaiah 59:10**)
- Therefore this is **what** the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Look! My own servants **will** eat, but **you** yourselves **will go** hungry. Look! My own servants **will** drink, but **you** yourselves **will go** thirsty. Look! My own servants **will** rejoice, but **you** yourselves **will** suffer shame. (**Isaiah 65:13**)
- And he continued saying to me; Son of man, here I am breaking the rods around which ring-shaped loaves are suspended, in Jerusalem, and they **will have** to eat bread by weight and in anxious care, and it **will** be by measure and in horror that they **will** drink water itself. (**Ezekiel 4:16**)
- When I send the injurious arrows of the famine upon them, which must prove to be for ruination, which arrows I shall send to bring **you** people to ruin, even famine I shall increase upon **you** people and I **will** break **your** rods around which ring-shaped loaves are suspended. (**Ezekiel 5:16**)
- And you kept decking yourself with gold and silver, and your attire was fine linen and costly material and an embroidered garment. Fine flour and honey and oil were **what** you ate, and you grew to be very, very pretty, and gradually you became fit for royal position. (**Ezekiel 16:13**)

- While the bridegroom was delaying, they all nodded and went to sleep. (**Matthew 25:5**)
- Right in the middle of the night there arose a cry; Here is the bridegroom! Be on **YOUR** way out to meet him. (**Matthew 25:6**)
- Then all those virgins rose and put their lamps in order. (**Matthew 25:7**)
- Keep on the watch, therefore, because **YOU** do not **know** on **what** day **YOUR** Lord is coming. (**Matthew 24:42**)
- Taste and see that Yehowah is good, O **YOU** people, happy is the able-bodied man that takes refuge in him. (**Psalms 34:8**)
- Cure sick people, raise up dead persons, make lepers clean, expel demons. **You received** free, give free. (**Matthew 10:8**)
- Keep awake, then, all the time making supplication that **YOU** may succeed in escaping all these things that are destined to occur, and in standing before the Son of man. (**Luke 21:36**)
- Keeping a tight grip on the word of life, that I may **have** cause for exultation in Christ's day, that I did not run in vain or work hard in vain. (**Philippians 2:16**)
- So then produce fruit that befits repentance. (**Matthew 3:8**)
- Therefore, since we **have** these promises, beloved ones, let us cleanse ourselves of every defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in God's fear. (**2 Corinthians 7:1**)
- Wherefore he says; Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and the Christ **will** shine upon you. (**Ephesians 5:14**)
- Look! I am coming as a **thief**. Happy is the one that stays awake and keeps his outer garments, that he may not walk naked and people look upon his shamefulness. (**Revelation 16:15**)
- Keep on the watch, therefore, because **YOU** do not **know** on **what** day **YOUR** Lord is coming. (**Matthew 24:42**)
- But **know** this, that if the householder had known at **what hour** the **thief** would **come**, he would **have** kept watching and not **have** let his house be broken into. (**Luke 12:39**)

- He that is walking faultless **will** be saved, but he that is made crooked in his ways **will** fall at once. (**Proverbs 28:18**)
- And the crash of revolters and that of sinful ones **will** be at the same time, and those leaving Yehowah **will come** to their finish. (**Isaiah 1:28**)
- Tremble, **you** women who are at ease! Be agitated, **you** careless ones! Undress and make yourselves naked, and gird sackcloth upon the loins. (**Isaiah 32:11**)
- Why is it that, when I came in, there was no one? When I called, there was nobody answering? Has my hand become in fact so short that it cannot redeem, or is there in me no power to deliver? Look! With my rebuke I dry up the sea, I make rivers a wilderness. Their fish stink due to there being no water, and they die because of thirst. (**Isaiah 50:2**)
- Therefore this is **what** the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; I **will** also cause a blast of windstorms to burst forth in my rage, and in my anger there **will** occur a flooding downpour, and in rage there **will** be hailstones for an extermination. (**Ezekiel 13:13**)
- But **know** one thing, that if the householder had known in **what** watch the **thief** was coming, he would **have** kept awake and not allowed his house to be broken into. (**Matthew 24:43**)
- Therefore keep on the watch, for **you** do not **know** when the master of the house is coming, whether late in the day or at midnight or at cockcrowing or early in the morning. (**Mark 13:35**)
- **You** also, keep ready, because at an **hour** that **you** do not think likely the Son of man is coming. (**Luke 12:40**)
- But if we would discern **what** we ourselves are, we would not be judged. (**1 Corinthians 11:31**)
- For **you** yourselves **know** quite well that Yehowah's day is coming exactly as a **thief** in the night. (**1 Thessalonians 5:2**)
- Just the same, hold fast **what you have** until I **come**. (**Revelation 2:25**)
- All those for whom I **have** affection I reprove and discipline. Therefore be zealous and **repent**. (**Revelation 3:19**)
