Revelation 3:8" I know your deeds, look! I have set before you an opened door, which no one can shut, that you have a little power, and you kept my word and did not prove false to my name.

- And this Good News of the kingdom will be preached in all the inhabited earth for a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come. (Matthew 24:14)
- In the beginning the Word was, and the Word was with God, and the Word was a god. (John 1:1)
- This one was in the beginning with God. (John 1:2)
- So the Word became flesh and resided among us, and we had a view of his glory, a glory such as belongs to an only-begotten son from a father, and he was full of undeserved kindness and truth. (John 1:14)
- And I saw in the right hand of the One seated upon the throne a scroll written within and on the reverse side, sealed tight with seven seals. (Revelation 5:1)
- And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice; Who is worthy to open the scroll and loose its seals? (Revelation 5:2)
- But neither in heaven nor upon earth nor underneath the earth was there a single one able to open the scroll or to look into it. (Revelation 5:3)
- And I gave way to a great deal of weeping because no one was found worthy to open the scroll or to look into it. (Revelation 5:4)
- But one of the elders says to me; Stop weeping. Look! The Lion that is of the tribe of Judah, the root of David, has conquered so as to open the scroll and its seven seals. (Revelation 5:5)
- Yehowah has bared his holy arm before the eyes of all the nations, and all the ends of the earth must see the salvation of our God. (Isaiah 52:10)
- Who has put faith in the thing heard by us? And as for the arm of Yehowah, to whom has it been revealed? (Isaiah 53:1)

- For who were they that heard and yet provoked to bitter anger?
  Did not, in fact, all do so who went out of Egypt under Moses?
  (Hebrews 3:16)
- Moreover, with whom did God become disgusted for forty years?
   Was it not with those who sinned, whose carcasses fell in the wilderness? (Hebrews 3:17)
- But to whom did he swear that they should not enter into his rest except to those who acted disobediently? (Hebrews 3:18)
- So we see that they could not enter in because of lack of faith. (Hebrews 3:19)
- Beware, brothers, for fear there should ever develop in any one of you a wicked heart lacking faith by drawing away from the living God. (Hebrews 3:12)
- Consequently let him that thinks he is standing beware that he does not fall. (1 Corinthians 10:12)
- And he proceeded to say; Listen, please, O house of David. Is it such a little thing for you to tire out men, that you should also tire out my God? (Isaiah 7:13)
- Why do you people keep paying out money for what is not bread, and why is your toil for what results in no satisfaction? Listen intently to me, and eat what is good, and let your soul find its exquisite delight in fatness itself. (Isaiah 55:2)
- And I will destine you men to the sword, and you will all of you bow down to being slaughtered, for the reason that I called, but you did not answer, I spoke, but you did not listen, and you kept doing what was bad in my eyes, and the thing in which I took no delight you chose. (Isaiah 65:12)
- Listen, O earth! Here I am bringing in calamity upon this people as the fruitage of their thoughts, for they paid no attention to my very own words, and my law, they also kept rejecting it.

  (Jeremiah 6:19)
- But they did not listen, neither did they incline their ear, but they went walking in the counsels in the stubbornness of their bad heart, so that they became backward in direction and not forward. (Jeremiah 7:24)

- I know your deeds, and your labor and endurance, and that you cannot bear bad men, and that you put those to the test who say they are apostles, but they are not, and you found them liars. (Revelation 2:2)
- For a large door that leads to activity has been opened to me, but there are many opposers. (1 Corinthians 16:9)
- Now when I arrived in Troas to declare the Good News about the Christ, and a door was opened to me in the Lord. (2 Corinthians 2:12)
